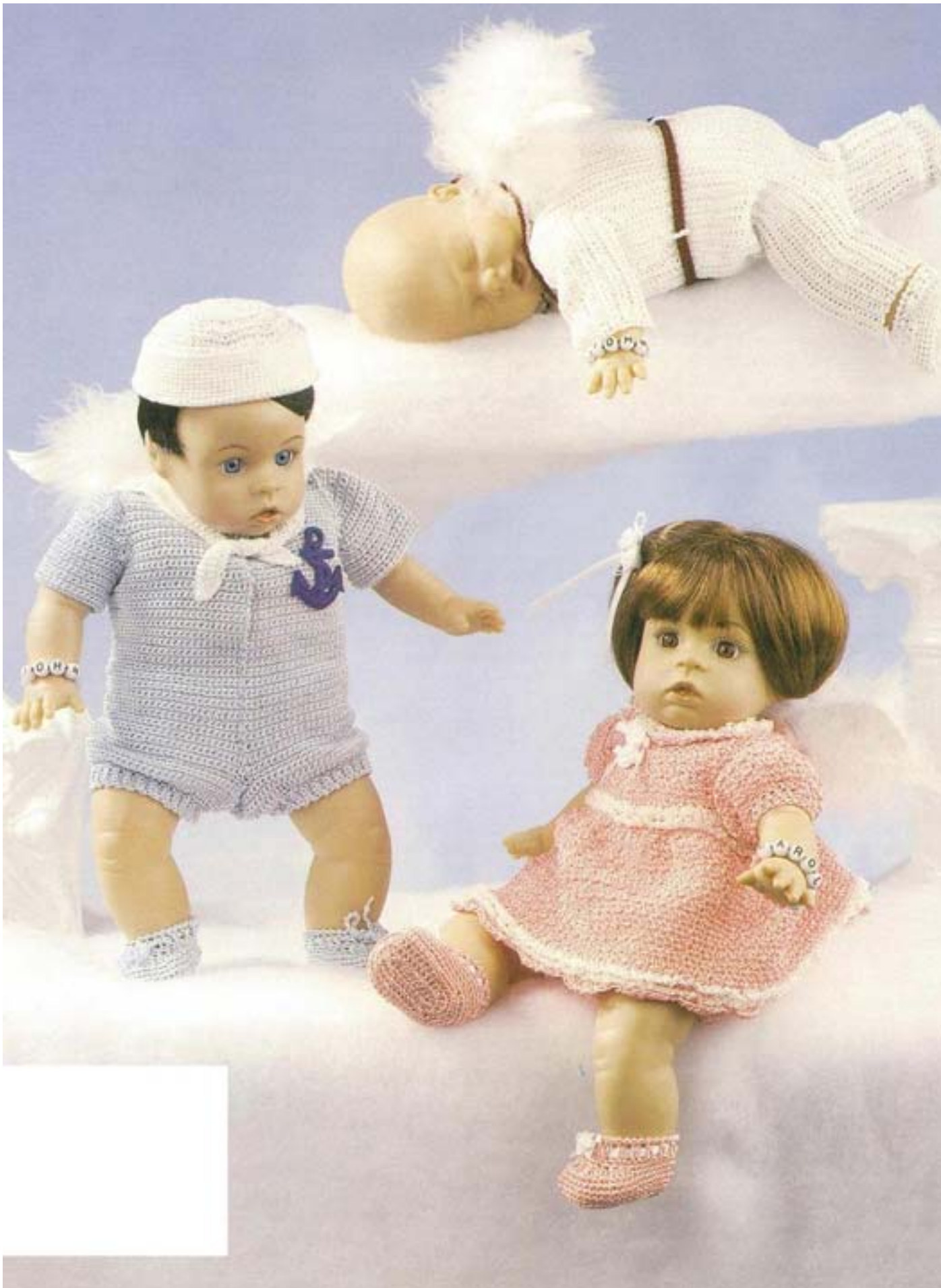

CROCHET ANGEL BABIES

CAROLYN

(Shown on back cover at bottom.)

FINISHED SIZE:

Fits 12" baby doll.

MATERIALS:

America's Best Rayon Crochet Thread Art. 137 by Elmore-Pisgah Inc. or size 10 crochet cotton thread:

300 yds. Baby Pink #47

80 yds. Queenslace #5 (off-white)

Brown-eyed 12" Soft Body Baby Doll #85000 by Syndee's Crafts, Ltd.

Small brown Wispy-style Wig #53002 by Syndee's™ Crafts, Ltd.

1 pair of 7" Angel Wings #164-56 by Mangelsen's

1 package each of Alphabet Beads #0791-14 and Multi-Color 3mm Round Spacer Beads #0791-13 by Darice

6 small white ribbon roses

1 yd. of white 1/8" ribbon

13" of white Elastic Cord #1125- 66 by Darice

3 small snaps

3/4" pin back

Pink sewing thread

Craft glue

Tapestry and sewing needles

No. 7 steel hook or hook needed to obtain gauge

GAUGE:

8 sts = 1"; 7 (dc, sc) pattern st rows = 1".

BASIC STITCHES:

Ch, si st, sc, bdc, dc, tr.

DRESS

Row 1: With baby pink. ch 41, sc in second ch from hook, sc in each ch across, turn. (40 sc made)

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first st, 2 sc in next st, (sc in next st, 2 sc in next st) across, turn. (60 sc)

Row 3; Ch 1, sc in first st, dc in next st, (sc in next st, dc in next st) across, turn. (60 sts)

Rows 4-5: Ch 1, sc in each dc and dc in each sc across, turn.

Row 6: Ch 1, sc in first st, dc in next st, sc in next st, dc in next st, * (sc, dc) in each of next 2 sts. (sc in next st, dc in next st) 3 times; repeat from * across, turn. (74 sts)

Row 7: Ch 1, sc in each dc and dc in each sc across, turn.

Row 8: Ch 1, sc in first st, dc in next st, * (sc, dc) in each of next 2 sts, (sc in next st, dc in next st) 3 times: repeat from * across, turn. (92 sts)

Row 9: Ch 1, sc in each dc and dc in each sc across, turn.

Row 10: Ch 1, sc in first st, dc in next st, sc in next st, dc in next st, *(sc, dc) in each of next 2 sts, (sc in next st, dc in next st) 3 times; repeat from * across, turn. (114 sts)

Row 11: Ch 1, sc in each dc and dc in each sc across, turn.

Row 12: Ch 1, sc in first st, dc in next st. (sc in next st, dc in next st) 9 times: for **armhole**, ch 13, skip next 20 sts: (sc in next st, dc in next st) 17 times; for **armhole**, ch

13, skip next 20 sts; (sc in next st, dc in next st) 10 times, turn. (74 sts, 26 chs)

Row 13: Ch 1, sc in first st, dc in next st. (sc in next st or ch, dc in next st or ch) across, turn. (100 sts)

Row 14: Ch 1, sc in first st, dc in next st, (sc in next st, dc in next st) 15 times, (sc, dc) in each of next 2 sts, (sc in next st, dc in next st) 16 times, [sc. dc] in each of next 2 sts. (sc in next st. dc in next st) 16 times, turn. (104 sts)

Row 15: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 16: Working this row in **back lps** (see Stitch Guide), ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Rows 17-18: Repeat rows 15-16.

Row 19: Ch 1, sc in first st, dc in next st, (sc, dc) in each of next 2 sts, * sc in next st, dc in next st, (sc, dc) in each of next 2 sts; repeat from * across, turn. {156 sts}

Rows 20-27: Ch 1, sc in each dc and dc in each sc across; matching last dc with fourth dc of row, lap last 4 sts of row 27 over First 4 sts: turn.

Rnd 28: Working through both thicknesses, (sl st, ch 1, sc) in first st, dc in next st, sc in next st, dc in next st; working in remaining sts of row 27, (sc in next st, dc in next st) around, join with sl st in first sc, **turn.** (152 sts)

Rnds 29-42: Ch 1, skip joining sl st, sc in each dc and dc in each sc around, join with sl st in first sc, **turn.**

Rnd 43: Ch 1, sc in each st around. join, **turn.**

Rjad 44: Working this md in **back lps**, ch 1, sc in each st around, join. **turn.**

Rnd 45: Working in **both lps**, ch 1, sc in each st around, join, **turn.**

Rnd 46: Working this md in **back lps**, ch 2, hdc in each st around, join with sl sl in top of ch-2. **do not turn.**

Rnd 47: Working in **both lps**, ch 1, sc in first st, skip next 3 sts, 8 tr in next st, skip next 3 sts. (sc in next st, skip next 3 sts, 8 tr in next st, skip next 3 sts) around, join. Fasten off.

Dress Ruffles

For **first Ruffle**, with top of Dress facing you, working in remaining **front lps** of row 15, join off-white with sc in first st, (ch 3, sc) in each st across. Fasten off.

For **remaining Ruffles**, working in remaining **front lps** of row 17, rnd 43 and rnd 45. repeat first Ruffle.

Sleeves

Rnd 1: Join baby pink with sc in center ch of ch-13 at center bottom of one armhole on Dress, sc in next 5 chs, insert hook in next ch, yo, pull lp through, insert hook in side of next sc on row 12, yo, pull lp through, insert hook in next skipped st on row 11, yo, pull lp through, yo, pull through all 4 lps on hook (decrease made), 2 sc in next 18 skipped sts, insert hook in next skipped st, yo, pull lp through, insert hook in side of next sc on row 12, yo, pull lp through, insert hook in next ch of ch-13, yo, pull lp through, yo, pull through all 4 lps on hook (decrease made), sc in last 5 chs, join with sl st in first sc, **turn.** (49 sc made)

Rnd 2: Ch 1, skip joining sl st, sc in next 3 sts, sc next 2 sts tog, sc in next st, (dc in next st, sc in next st) 18 times, sc in next st, sc next 2 sts tog, sc in next 3 sts, skip last st, join, **turn.** (46 sts)

Rnd 3: Ch 1, skip joining sl st, (sc in next st, sc next 2 sts tog) 2 times, sc in next st, (dc in next st, sc in next st) 16 times, dc in next st, (sc next 2 sts tog, sc in next st) 2 times, join, **turn.** (42 sts)

Rnd 4: Ch 1, skip joining sl st, sc in next st, sc next 2 sts tog, sc in next 2 sts. (dc in next st, sc in next st) 17 times, sc next 2 sts tog, sc in last st, join, **turn.** (40 sts)

Rnd 5: Ch 1, skip joining sl st, sc in next 4 sts, (dc in next st, sc in next st) 17 times, sc in last 2 sts, join, **turn.**

Rnd 6: Ch 1, skip joining sl st, sc in next st, sc next 2 sts tog, (sc in next st, dc in next st) 17 times, sc next 2 sts tog, sc in last st, join, **turn.** (38 sts)

Rnd 7: Ch 1, skip joining sl st, sc next 2 sts tog, dc next 2 sts tog, (sc in next st, dc in next st) 17 times, join, **turn.** (36 sts)

Rnd 8: Ch 1, skip joining sl st, (sc in next st, dc in next st) around, join, **turn.**

Rnd 9: Ch 1, skip joining sl st, (sc next 2 sts tog, dc next 2 sts tog, sc in next st, dc in next st) 6 times, join, **do not turn.** (24 sts)

Rnd 10: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Rnd 11: Working this rnd in **front lps**, ch 1, sc in each st around, join. Fasten off. Repeat on other armhole.

COLLAR

Row 1; Working in remaining lps on opposite side of starting ch on row 1 of Dress, for **first half**, skip first 5 chs, join baby pink with sc in next ch, sc in next 13 chs leaving remaining chs unworked, turn. (14 sc made)

Row 2: Ch 1, skip first st, (sc in next st, dc in next st) 6 times, sc in last st, turn. (13 sts)

Row 3: Ch 3, (sc in next st, dc in next st) 5 times, sc in next st leaving last st unworked, turn. (11sts)

Row 4: Ch 1, skip first st, (sc in next st, dc in next st) 5 times, sc in last st, turn. Fasten off. [11 sts)

Row 1: Working in remaining lps on opposite side of starting ch on row 1 of Dress, for **second half**, skip next 2 unworked chs, join baby pink with sc in next ch, sc in next 13 chs leaving last 5 chs unworked, turn. (14 sc made)

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first st, (dc in next st, sc in next st) across leaving last st unworked, turn. (13 sts)

Row 3: Ch 1, skip first st, (sc in next st, dc in next st) across, turn. (12 sts)

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in first st, (dc in next st, sc in next st) 5 times leaving last st unworked, turn. Fasten off. (11 sts)

Row 5: Working in sts and in ends of rows across edges of both halves, join baby pink with sc in end of row 1 on first half, sc in next 3 rows, sc in each st across row 4, sc in next 4 rows, sc in 2 center skipped sts, sc in next 4 rows on second half, sc in each st across row 4, sc in next 4 rows, **do not turn.** Fasten off. (40 sc)

Row 6: Working this row in **back lps**, join baby pink with sc in first st of last row, skip next 3 sts, 7 tr in next st, (skip next 2 sts, sc in next st, skip next 2 sts, 7 tr in next st) 5 times, skip next 3 sts, sc in next st, sl st in last st. Fasten off.

Collar Ruffles

For **first Ruffle**, join off-white with sc in first st of last row on Collar, (ch 3, sc) in each st across. Fasten off,

For **second Ruffle**, working in remaining **front lps** of row 5, join off-white with sc in first st, (ch 3, sc) in each st across. Fasten off.

Tack scalloped edge of Collar in place around top of Dress.

PANTEES Side (make 2)

Row 1: Starting at bottom edge, with baby pink. ch 39, sc in second ch from hook, sc in each ch across, turn. (38 sc made)

Row 2: Ch 1, (sc, dc) in first st, * (sc in next st, dc in next st) 2 times, (sc, dc) in each of next 2 sts; repeat from * across to last st, (sc, dc) in last st, turn. (52 sts)

Rows 3-4: Ch 1, (sc, dc) in each of first 2 sts, (sc in next st, dc in next st) across to last 2

sts, (sc, dc) in each of last 2 sts, turn. (56 sts, 60 sts)

Row 5: Ch 1, sc in each dc and dc in each sc across, turn.

Rows 6-8; Repeat rows 4 and 5 alternately, ending with row 4. At end of last row (68 sts).

Row 9: Sl st in first 4 sts for front shaping; ch 1, (sc in next st, dc in next st) across leaving last 8 sts unworked for back shaping, turn. (56 sts)

Row 10: Ch 1, skip first 2 sts, (sc in next st, dc in next st) across to last 4 sts, sc in next st, dc next 2 sts tog, skip last st, turn. (52 sts)

Row 11: Ch 1, skip first 2 sts, (sc in next st, dc in next st) across, turn. (50 sts)

Rows 12-21: Ch 1, sc in each dc and dc in each sc across, turn. At end of last row, fasten off. (50 sts)

On each Side piece, match ends of rows 1-8 and sew together, forming in seam.

Matching front edges and back edges, sew Side pieces together.

Tack or tie ends of 9" piece elastic cord together.

For **waistband**, covering elastic cord as you work (see Stitch Guide), join baby pink with sc in first st at center back seam on top of Panties, sc in each st around, join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

BOOTIE (make 2)

Rnd 1: With baby pink, ch 11, 2 hdc in third ch from hook, hdc in next 7 chs, 5 hdc in last ch; working in remaining lps on opposite side of starting ch, hdc in next 7 chs, 2 hdc in last ch, join with sl st in top of ch-2. (23 hdc made)

Rnd 2: Ch 2, 2 hdc in each of next 2 sts, hdc in next 8 sts, 2 hdc in each of next 3 sts, hdc in next 9 sts, 2 hdc in last st, join. (30 hdc)

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in first 2 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts, hdc in next 6 sts, 2 hdc in each of next 2 sts, hdc in next st, 2 hdc in each of next 2 sts, hdc in next 6 sts, sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in last st, join with sl st in first sc. (36 sts)

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in first 3 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 6 sts, hdc in next; 5 sts, (2 tide in next st, hdc in next st) 4 times, hdc in next 4 sts, sc in next 7 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in last st, join. (42 sts)

Rnd 5: Working this rnd in **back lps**, ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Rnds 6-8: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join,

Rnd 9: Ch 1, sc in first 9 sts, (dc next 2 sts tog) 3 times, (tr next 3 sts tog) 4 times, (dc next 2 sts tog) 3 times, sc in last 9 sts, sc in joining sl st, join. (29 sts)

Rnd 10: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Rnd 11: Ch 3, dc in each st around, join with sl st in top of ch-3.

Rnd 12: Working from left to right, ch 1, **reverse** sc (see Stitch Guide) in each st around, join with sl st in first st. Fasten off.

Beginning at center front, weave a 10" piece of white ribbon through sts of rnd 11, going over one and under one. Tie ends of ribbon in a bow. Trim ends to desired length.

Glue one ribbon rose to center of bow.

BRACELET

Spell "CAROLYN" or desired name with alphabet beads and string beads on 4" piece elastic cord; add amount of spacer beads needed to fit around doll's wrist on cord. Wrap Bracelet around wrist and tie ends of cord together. Trim off excess ends of cord.

BARRETTE

Fold a 5" piece of white ribbon in half, forming a V shape; glue fold to center of pin back. Glue two ribbon roses to pin back. Place Barrette in doll's hair as desired,

FINISHING

Sew snaps evenly spaced down back opening of Dress.

Tack or glue wings to back of Dress about 1" from top edge and about 1/2" from back opening edges.

Fold a 2" piece of white ribbon in half, forming a V shape, tack or glue fold to center front of Dress just below edge of Collar. Tack or glue one ribbon rose over fold. Tack or glue one ribbon rose below first rose.

Place Dress, Panties, Booties and Bracelet on doll.

JOHN

(Shown on back cover at bottom.)

FINISHED SIZE:

Fits 12" baby doll.

America's Best Rayon Crochet Thread Art, 137 by Elmore-Pisgah Inc. or size 10 crochet cotton thread:

300 yds. Baby Blue #23

80 yds. White #1

Blue-eyed 12" Soft Body Baby Doll #85100 by Syndee's" Crafts, Ltd.

Small black Wispy-style Wig #53001 by Syndee's™ Crafts, Ltd.

1 pair of 7" Angel Wings #164-56 by Mangelsch's

1 package each of Alphabet Beads #0791-14 and Multi-Color 3mm Round Spacer

Beads #0791-13 by Darice

1 1/2" blue anchor applique

2 blue 9mm acrylic stars

4" of white Elastic Cord #1125-66 by Darice

2 small snaps

Lt. blue sewing thread

Craft glue

Tapestry and sewing needles

NO. 7 steel hook or hook needed to obtain gauge

GAUGE:

8 sts = 1"; 12 sc rows = 1".

BASIC STITCHES

Ch, sl st, sc, hdc, dc, tr.

ROMPER Leg (make 2)

Row 1: With baby blue, ch 5, sc in second ch from hook, sc in each ch across, turn. (4 sc made)

Rows 2-58: Working these rows in **back lps** (see Stitch Guide), ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 59: Match first and last rows; working through both thicknesses, sl st in each st across.

Rnd 60: Working in ends of rows around edge, ch 1, 2 sc in first row, (sc in next 3 rows, 2 sc in next row) around to last row, sc in last row, join with sl st in first sc. (73 sc)

Rnds 61-66: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join, **turn**. At end of last rnd. fasten off.

Body

Rnd 1; Match joining seam of each Leg piece together, count 15 sts to right of seam and

mark 15th st; working through both thicknesses, join baby blue with sc in marked st, sc in next 19 sts (crotch seam made); working in remaining sts of first Leg, sc in each st around to beginning of crotch seam, sc in seam, sc in each remaining st of second Leg around to end of crotch seam, join with sc in first st on first Leg, **turn.** (107 sc)

Rnds 2-26: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join, **turn.**

Row 27: Working in rows, ch 1, sc in each st across, **do not join,** turn.

Row 28; For **front inside placket,** ch 5, sc in second ch from hook, sc in next 3 chs; sc in each st across, turn. (111 sc)

Rows 29-40: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 41: For **first front,** ch 1, sc in first 25 sts, sc next 2 sts tog leaving remaining sts unworked, turn. (26 sc)

Row 42: Ch 1, sc first 2 sts tog, sc in each st across, turn. (25 sc)

Row 43: Ch 1, sc in each st across to last 2 sts, sc last 2 sts tog, turn. (24 sc)

Rows 44-47: Repeat rows 42 and 43 alternately. At end of last row (20 sc).

Rows 48-53: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 54: For **shoulder,** ch 1, sc in first 12 sts, sc next 2 sts tog leaving last 6 sts unworked, turn. (13 sc)

Row 55: Ch 1, sc first 2 sts tog, sc in each st across, turn. (12 sc)

Row 56: Ch 1, sc in each st across to last 2 sts, sc last 2 sts tog, turn. (11 sc)

Rows 57-60: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 61: Ch 1, sc in first 6 sts, sl st in next 2 sts leaving last 3 sts unworked. Fasten off.

Row 41: For **armhole,** skip next 5 unworked sts on row 40; for **back,** join baby blue with sc in next st, sc in next 40 sts leaving remaining sts unworked, turn, (41 sc)

Rows 42-44: Ch 1, sc first 2 sts tog, sc in each st across to last 2 sts, sc last 2 sts tog, turn. (39, 37, 35)

Rows 45-58: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 59: For **first shoulder,** sl st in first 5 sts, sc in next 6 sts; for **neckline,** ch 1, sl st in next 13 sts, ch 1;

for **second shoulder,** sc in next 6 sts, sl st in last 5 sts. Fasten off.

Row 41: For **armhole,** skip next 5 unworked sts on row 40; for **second front,** join baby blue with sc in next st, sc next 2 sts tog, sc in each st across, turn. (32 sc)

Row 42: Ch 1, sc in each st across to last 2 sts, sc last 2 sts tog, turn. (31 sc)

Row 43: Ch 1, sc first 2 sts tog, sc in each st across, turn. (30 sc)

Rows 44-47; Repeat rows 42 and 43 alternately. At end of last row (26 sc).

Rows 48-53: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 54: Sl st in first 12 sts, ch 1, sc next 2 sts tog, sc in last 12 sts, turn. (13 sc)

Row 55: Ch 1, sc in first 11 sts, sc next 2 sts tog leaving sl sts unworked, turn. (12 sc)

Row 56: Ch 1, sc first 2 sts tog, sc in each st across, turn. (11 sc)

Rows 57-60: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 61: Sl st in first 5 sts, sc in last 6 sts. Fasten off.

Matching sts of front shoulders to sts of back shoulders, sew edges together forming shoulder seams. Tack bottom edge of inside placket in place.

SLEEVES

Row 1: Working in ends of rows at top of one armhole, join baby blue with sc in row 53, sc in next 13 rows, sl st in next st, turn. (15 sts made)

Rows 2-12: Sc in sl st, sc in each sc across, sc in next unworked row, sl st in next row, turn. At end of last To-w(37sts).

Rows 13-15: Skip sl st and first sc, sc in each sc across, sl st in next unworked row or st, turn. At end of last row (34 sts).

Rnd 16: Working in rnds, skip sl st and first sc, sc in each st around, sc in each

remaining skipped st at bottom of armhole, join with sl st in first sc, **turn.** (36 sc)
Rnds 17-23: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join, **turn.** At end of last rnd, fasten off.
Repeat on other armhole.

COLLAR

Row 1: With white, ch 27; working in ends of rows across neckline of Body, sc in row 55 on right front shoulder, sc in each row and in each st across to row 55 on left front shoulder with 3 sc in each shoulder seam, ch 28, turn.

Row 2: Sc in second ch from hook, sc in each ch and in each st across to center st of next 3-sc group, 3 sc in center st (corner made), sc in each st across to center st of next 3-sc group. 3 sc in center st (corner made), sc in each st and in each ch across, turn.

Rows 3-4: Ch 1, skip first sc, (sc in each st across to center st of next corner, 3 sc in center st) 2 times, sc in each st across to last 2 sts, sc last 2 sts tog, turn. At end of last row, fasten off.

Row 5: Skip first 16 sts, join white with sl st in next st, (sc in each st across to center st of next corner, 3 sc in center st) 2 times, sc in each st across to last 18 sts, sc next 2 sts tog leaving remaining sts unworked, turn.

Rows 6-8: Ch 1, skip first st, (sc in each st across to center st of next corner, 3 sc in center st) 2 times, sc in each st across to last 2 sts, sc last 2 sts tog. turn. At end of last row, fasten off.

Row 9: Join white with sc in center st of first corner, sc in each st across to center st of second corner, turn.

Rows 10-22: Ch 1, skip first st, sc in each st across, turn. At end of last row, fasten off.

Row 23: Join white with sc in end of row 1, sc in end of each row and in each skipped st across to row 22, 3 sc in first st of row 22, sc in each st across to last st of row 22, 3 sc in last st» sc in end of each row and in each skipped st across to end of row 1. Fasten off.

HAT

Rnd 1: With white, ch 3, 7 hdc in third ch from hook, join with sl st in top of ch-2. (8 hdc made)

Rnd 2: (Ch 2, hdc) in first st, 2 hdc in each st around, join. (18 hdc)

Rnd 3: Ch 2, 2 hdc in next st, (hdc in next st, 2 hdc in next st) around, join. (24 hdc)

Rnd 4: (Ch 2, hdc) in first st, hdc in next 2 sts, (2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 2 sts) around, join. (32 hdc)

Rnd 5: Ch 2, hdc in next 2 sts, 2 hdc in next st, (hdc in next 3 sts, 2 hdc in next st) around, join. (40 hdc)

Rnd 6: (Ch 2, hdc) in first st, hdc in next 4 sts, (2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 4 sts) around, join. (48 hdc)

Rnd 7: Ch 2, hdc in next 4 sts, 2 hdc in next st, (hdc in next 5 sts, 2 hdc in next st) around, join. (56 hdc)

Rnd 8: (Ch 2, hdc) in first st, hdc in next 6 sts, (2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 6 sts) around, join. (64 hdc)

Rnd 9: Ch 2, hdc in next 6 sts, 2 hdc in next st, (hdc in next 7 sts, 2 hdc in next st) around, join. (72 hdc)

Rnd 10: (Ch 2, hdc) in first st, hdc in next 8 sts, (2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 8 sts) around, join. (80 hdc)

Rnd 11: Ch 2, hdc in next 8 sts, 2 hdc in next st, (hdc in next 9 sts, 2 hdc in next st) around, join. (88 hdc)

Rnd 12: Working this rnd in **back lps**, ch 2, hdc in each st around, join.

Rnds 13-19: Ch 2, hdc in each st around, join. At end of last rnd, **turn.**

Rnd 20: For **brim**, working this rnd in **back lps**, ch 1, sc in each st around, join with sl st

in first **sc**, **do not turn**.

Rnds 21-29: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join. At end of last rnd, fasten off. Fold brim up.

BOOTIE(make 2)

Rnd 1: With baby blue, ch 11, 2 hdc in third ch from hook, hdc in next 7 chs, 5 hdc in last ch; working in remaining lps on opposite side of starting ch, hdc in next 7 chs, 2 hdc in last ch, join with sl st in top of ch-2. (23 hdc made)

Rnd 2: Ch 2, 2 hdc in each of next 2 sts, hdc in next 8 sts, 2 hdc in each of next 3 sts, hdc in next 9 sts, 2 hdc in last st, join. (30 hdc)

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in first 2 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts, hdc in next 6 sts, 2 hdc in each of next 2 sts, hdc in next st, 2 hdc in each of next 2 sts, hdc in next 6 sts, sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in last st, join with sl st in first sc. (36 Sts)

Rnd 4: Ch 1. sc in first 3 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 6 sts, hdc in next 5 sts, (2 hdc in next st, hdc in next st) 4 times, hdc in next 4 sts, sc in next 7 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in last st, join. (42 sts)

Rnd 5: Working this rnd in **back lps**, ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Rnds 6-8: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Rnd 9: Ch 1, sc in first 9 sts, (dc next 2 sts tog) 3 times, (tr next 3 sts log) 4 times, (dc next 2 sts tog) 3 times, sc in last 9 sts, sc in joining sl st, join, (29 sts)

Rnd 10: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Rnd 11: Ch 3, dc in each st around. join with sl st in top of ch-3,

Rnd 12: Working from left to right, ch 1, **reverse sc** (see Stitch Guide) in each st around, join, with sl st in first st. Fasten off.

Drawstring

With baby blue, ch until piece measures 9" long. Fasten off.

Beginning at center front, weave Drawstring through sts of rnd 11, going over one and under one. Tie ends of Drawstring in a bow.

BRACELET

Spell "JOHN" or desired name with alphabet beads and string beads on 4" piece elastic cord; add amount of spacer beads needed to fit around doll's wrist on cord. Wrap Bracelet around wrist and tie ends of cord together. Trim off excess ends of cord.

FINISHING

Sew snaps evenly spaced down front opening on Romper, Tack or glue anchor applique to left

front of Romper (see photo). Glue acrylic stars to each back corner of Collar.

Tack or glue wings to center back of Collar about 1" from neck edge.

Place Romper, Hat, Booties and Bracelet on doll. Tie ends of Collar in a loose knot on front of Romper (see photo).

GAUGE

BASIC STITCHES:

Ch, sl st, sc, hdc, dc, tr,

DRESS

Yoke Front

Row 1: With white, ch 67, sc in second ch from hook, sc in each ch across, turn, (66 sc made)

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 3: Sl st in first 6 sts, ch 1, sc in each st across leaving last 6 sts, unworked, turn. (54 sc)

Rows 4-5: Ch 1, skip first st, sc in each st across to last 2 sts, sc last 2 sts tog, turn. (52 sc, 50 sc)

Rows 6-20: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 21: For **first shoulder**, uh 1, Sc in **first 19** sts, sc **next 2** sts **tog** leaving last 29 sts unworked, turn. (20 sc)

Row 22: Ch 1, skip first st, sc in each st across, turn. (19 sc)

Row 23: Ch 1, sc in each st across to last 2 sts, sc last 2 sts tog, turn. (18 sc)

Rows 24-26: Repeat rows 22 and 23 alternately, ending with row 22 and 15 sc.

Rows 27-30: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn. At end of last row, fasten off.

Row 21: For **second shoulder**, skip next 8 unworked sts on row 20. join white with sl st in next st, ch 1, sc same st as sl st and next st tog, sc in each st across, turn. (30 sc)

Row 22: Ch 1, sc in each st across to last 2 sts, sc last 2 sts tog, turn. (19 sc)

Row 23: Ch 1, skip first st, sc in each st across, turn. (18 sc)

Rows 24-26: Repeat rows 22 and 23 alternately, ending with row 22 and 15 sc.

Rows 27-30: Ch 1. sc in each st across, turn. At end of last row, fasten off.

Yoke Back (make 2)

Row 1: With lavender, ch 33, sc in second ch from hook, sc in each ch across, turn. (32 sc made)

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first 28 sts, sc next 2 sts tog leaving last 2 sts unworked, turn, (29 sc)

Row 3: Ch 1, skip first st, sc in each st across, turn. (28 sc)

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in each st across to last 2 sts, sc last 2 sts tog. turn. (27 sc)

Rows 5-25: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 26: For **shoulder**, ch 1, sc in first 17 sts, SC next 2 sts tog leaving last 8 sts unworked. turn. (18 sc)

Rows 27-29: Repeat rows 3 and 4 alternately, ending with row 3 and 15 sc.

Row 30: Ch 1, sc in each st across, Fasten off.

Matching sts of shoulder on each Yoke Back to sts of shoulders on Yoke Front, sew edges together, forming shoulder seams.

Matching ends of rows 1 and 2 on each Yoke Back to each end of rows 1 and 2 on Yoke Front, sew edges together, forming underarm seams.

SLEEVES

Row 1: Working in ends of rows at top of one armhole, join lavender with sc in row 15, (sc next 2 rows tog, sc in next row) 10 times, turn. (21 sc made)

Row 2: Ch 1, skip first st; **for shell**, 3 dc in next st (shell made); sc in next, st, (shell in next, st, sc in next St) 9 times, shell in next unworked row, sc in next 2 rows, turn. (12 sc, 11 shells)

Row 3: Ch 1, skip first st, (shell in next sc, sc in center st of next shell) 11 times, shell in next unworked row, sc in next 3 rows, turn.

Rows 4-5: Ch 1, skip first 1 sts, (shell in next sc, sc in center st of next shell) across, shell in next unworked row, sc in next 3 rows, turn.

Row 6: Ch 1, skip first 2 sts, (shell in next sc, sc in center st of next shell) across, shell in next unworked row, sc in next 2 rows, turn.

Rows 7-9: Ch 1, skip first st, (shell in next sc, sc in center st of next shell) across, shell in next unworked row, sc in next 2 rows, turn.

Rnd 10: Working in rnds, ch 1, skip first st, (shell in next sc, sc in center st of next shell) around, shell in next unworked row, sc in next row, skip next st at bottom of armhole, shell in next st, skip next 2 sts, sc in next st, skip last 2 sts, join with sl st in top of first dc, **turn.**

Rnd 11: Skip joining sl st, (shell in next sc, sc in center st of next shell) around, join, **turn.**

Rnds 12-13: Ch 1, sc first 2 sts tog, (sc next 2 sts tog) around, join with sl st in first sc, **turn.** At end of last rnd. fasten off,
Repeat on other armhole.

SKIRT

Row 1: Working in remaining lps on opposite side of starting ch at bottom edge of assembled Yoke, join lavender with sc in first ch, sc in next 5 chs, (2 sc in next ch, sc in next ch) across to last 6 chs, sc in last 6 chs, turn. (189 sc made)

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first st. (skip next st, shell in next st, skip next st, sc in next st) across, turn. (47 shells, 48 sc)

Row 3: (Ch 3, dc) in first st, (sc in center st of next shell, shell in next sc) across to last shell and last sc, sc in center st of next shell, 2 dc in last sc, turn. (47 sc, 46 shells, 4 dc)

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in first st, shell in next sc, (sc in center at of next shell, shell in next sc) across to last 2 sts, skip next st, sc in last st, turn. (48 sc, 47 shells)

Rows 5-9: Repeat rows 3 and 4 alternately, ending with row 3. At end of last row, match last st with center st of first shell, turn.

Rnd 10: Working through both thicknesses, (sl st, ch 1, sc) in first st, shell in next sc, sc in center st of next shell; working in remaining sts of row 9, (shell in next sc, sc in center st of next shell) around, join with sl st in first sc, **turn.** (46 shells. 46 sc)

Rnd 11: (Ch 3, 2 dc) in first sc, sc in center st of next shell, (shell in next sc, sc in center st of next shell) around, join with sl st in top of ch-3, turn.

Rnd 12: (Sl st, ch 1, sc) in next st, shell in next sc, (sc in center st of next shell, shell in next sc) around, join, **turn.**

Rnds 13-24: Repeat rnds 11 and 12 alternately. At end of last rnd, fasten off.

YOKE TRIM

Row 1: Working in neck edge on Yoke Front, join white with sc in end of row 30, sc in end of each row and in each st across to end of row 30 on opposite side of Yoke, turn. Fasten off. (28 sc made)

Row 2: Working this row in **back lps** (see Stitch Guide), join lavender with sc in first st, sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st, (sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st) across, turn. (35 sc)

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 4: Ch 1, skip first st, sc in next 3 sts, (2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts) across leaving last st unworked, turn. (39 sc)

Row 5: Ch 1, skip first st, sc in each st across leaving last st unworked, turn. (37 sc)

Row 6: Sl st in first 3 sts, sc in next st, (2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts) across leaving last 3 sts unworked, turn. (37 sc)

Row 7: Sl st in first 4 sts, sc in each st across leaving last 4 sts unworked, turn. (29 sc)

Row 8: Sl st in first 4 sts, sc in next st, (2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts) across leaving last 4 sts unworked, turn. (25 sc)

Row 9: Sl st in first 4 sts, sc in each st across leaving last 4 sts unworked, turn. (17 sc)

Rows 10-16: Ch 1, skip first st, sc in each st across leaving last st unworked, turn. At end of last row (3 sc).

Rows 17-20: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn. At end of last row, fasten off.

Row 21: Working in ends of rows and unworked sts at ends of rows across outer edge, join lavender with sc in end of row 2, sc in each row and in each st across to last row, 2 sc in first st on last row, sc in next st, 2 sc in last st; sc in each row and in each st across to opposite end of row 2, turn. (81 sc)

Row 22: Ch 1, sc in first st (skip next st, shell in next st, skip next st, sc in next st) across. Fasten off.

Tack row 21 of Yoke Trim in place over front of Yoke.

PANTIES SIDE(make 2)

Row 1: With lavender, ch 46, sc in second ch from hook, sc in each ch across, turn. (45 sc made)

Rows 2-3: Ch 1, 2 sc in first st, (sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st) across, **turn.** (57 sc, 72, sc)

Rows 4-10: Ch 1, 2 sc in first st, sc in each st across to last st, 2 sc in last st, turn. At end of last row (86 sc).

Row 11: St st in first 5 sts for front shaping, sc in each st across to last 12 sts, sc next 2 sts tog leaving last 10 sts unworked for back shaping, turn. (70 sc)

Rows 12-14: Ch 1, sc first 2 sts tog, sc in each st across to last 2 sts, sc last 2 sts tog, turn. (64 sc)

Rows 15-39: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn. At end of last row, fasten off.

On each Side piece, match ends of rows 1—9 and sew together, forming inseam.

Matching front edges and back edges, sew Side pieces together.

Tack or tie ends of 9" piece elastic cord together.

For **waistband**, covering elastic cord as you work (see Stitch Guide), join lavender with sc in first st at center back seam on top of Panties, sc in each st around, join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

BOOTIE (make 2)

Rnd 1: With lavender, ch 11, 2 hdc in third ch from hook, hdc in next 7 chs, 5 hdc in last ch; working in remaining lps on opposite side of starting ch, hdc in next 7 chs, 2 hdc in last ch, join with sl st in top of ch-2. (23 hdc made)

Rnd 2: Ch 2, 2 hdc in each of next 2 sts, hdc in next 8 sts, 2 hdc in each of next 3 sts, hdc in next 9 sts, 2 hdc in last st, join. (30 hdc)

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in first 2 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts, hdc in next 6 sts, 2 hdc in each of next 2 sts, hdc in next st, 2 hdc in each of next 2 sts, hdc in next 6 sts, sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in last st. join with sl st in first sc, (36 sts)

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in first 3 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 6 sts, hdc in next 5 sts, (2 hdc in next st, hdc in next st) 4 times, hdc in next 4 sts, sc in next 7 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in last st, join. (42 sts)

Rnd 5: Working this rnd in **back lps**, ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Rnds 6-8: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Rnd 9: Ch 1, sc in first 9 sts, (dc next 2 sts tog) 3 times, (tr next 3 sts tog) 4 times, (dc next 2 sts tog) 3 times, sc in last 9 sts, sc in joining sl st, join. (29 sts)

Rnd 10: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Rnd 11: Ch 3, dc in each st around, join with sl st in top of ch-3.

Rnd 12: Working from left to right, ch 1, **reverse** sc (see Stitch Guide) in each st around, join with sl st in first st. Fasten off.

Beginning at center front, weave a 10" piece of pink ribbon through sts of rnd 11, going over one and under one. Tie ends of ribbon in a bow. Trim ends to desired length.

BRACELET

Spell "ALICIA" or desired name with alphabet beads and string beads on 4" piece elastic cord; add amount of spacer beads needed to fit around doll's wrist on cord. Wrap Bracelet around wrist and tie ends of cord together. Trim off excess ends of cord.

BARRETTE

Glue two ribbon roses to pin. back. Place Barrette in doll's hair as desired.

FINISHING

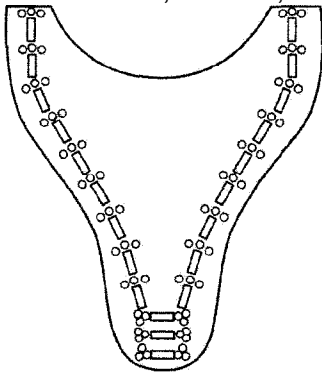
Sew snaps evenly spaced down back opening of Dress.

Tack or glue wings to back of Dress about 1" from top edge and about 1/2" from back opening edges.

Sew seed and bugle beads over row 21 of Yoke Trim as shown in illustration below.

Tack or glue one ribbon rose to center front of Yoke Trim just below neckline.

Place Dress, Panties, Booties and Bracelet on doll.

3 white 1/2" teddy bear buttons

18" of pink 1/8" ribbon

2" x 4" piece of clear acrylic or plastic from margarine lid

4" of white Elastic Cord #1125-66 by Darice

2 small snaps

Lt. green sewing thread

Tapestry and sewing needles

No. 7 steel hook or hook needed to obtain gauge

GAUGE:

8 sts = 1"; 10 sc rows = 1"; 7 (sc, dc) pattern rows = 1".

BASIC STITCHES:

Ch, sl st, sc, hdc, dc, tr.

BIB OVERALLS Leg (make 2)

Rnd 1: With mint green, ch 56, sl st in first ch to form ring, ch 1, sc in each ch **around**, join with sl st in first sc. (56 sc made)

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in first st, (dc in next st, sc in next st) around to last 5 sts, (dc, sc) in next st, dc in next st, (sc, dc) in next st, sc in next st, dc in last st, join, **turn**. (58 sts)

Rnd 4: Ch 1, skip joining sl st, sc in each dc and dc in each sc around, join, **turn**.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, skip joining sl st, (sc, dc) in each of first 2 sts. (sc in next st, dc in next st) around, join, **turn**. (60 sts)

Rnd 6: Ch 1, skip joining sl st, sc in each dc and dc in each sc around, join, **turn**.

Rnds 7-9: Ch 1, sc in first st, dc in next st, (sc, dc) in each of next 2 sts, (sc in next st, dc in next st) around, join, **turn**. At end of last rnd (66 sts).

Rnd 10: Ch 1, skip joining sl st, sc in each dc and dc in each sc around, join, **turn**.

Rnd 11: Ch 1, sc in first st, dc in next st, (sc, dc) in each of next 2 sts, (sc in next st, dc in next st) around, join, **turn**. (68 sts)

Rnds 12-16: Repeat rnds 10 and 11 alternately, ending with rnd 10 and 72 sts. At end of last rnd, fasten off.

Body

Rnd 1: Match joining seam of each Leg piece together; working through both thicknesses, join mint green with sc in first st past seam, sc in next 16 sts (crotch seam made); working in remaining sts of first Leg, (sc in next st, dc in next st) around to beginning of crotch seam; working in remaining sts of second Leg, (sc in next st, dc in next st) around to end of crotch seam, join with sc in first st on first Leg, **turn**. (110 sts made)

Rnds 2-4: Ch 1, skip joining sl st, sc in each dc and dc in each sc around, join, **turn**.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, skip joining sl st, (sc in next st, dc in next st) 26 times, sc next 2 sts tog, dc

next 2 sts tog, (sc in next st, dc in next st) 27 times, join, turn. (108sts)

Rnd 6: Ch 1, skip joining sl st, (sc in next st, dc in next st) 26 times, sc next 2 sts tog, dc next 2 sts tog, (sc in next st, dc in next st) 26 times, join, **turn.** 1106 sts)

Rnd 7: Ch 1, skip joining sl st, (sc in next st, dc in next st) 26 times, sc next 2 sts tog, dc next 2 sts tog, (sc in next st, dc in next st) 25 times, join, **turn.** (104 sts)

Rnd 8: Ch 1, skip joining sl st, *(sc in next st, dc in next st) 16 times, sc next 2 sts tog, dc next 2 sts tog; repeat from *, (sc in next st, dc in next st) 16 times, join, **turn.** (100 sts)

Rnd 9: Ch 1, skip joining sl st, * sc next 2 sts tog. dc next 2 sts tog. (sc in next st, dc in next st) 8 times; repeat from * 4 more times, join, **turn.** (90 sts)

Rnd 10: Ch 1, skip joining sl st, sc in each **dc** and dc in each sc around, join, **turn.**

Rnd 11: Ch 1, skip joining sl st, *sc next 2 sts tog, dc next 2 sts tog, (sc in next st, dc in next st) 7 times; repeat from * 4 more times, join, **turn.** (80 sts)

Rnds 12-18: Ch 1, skip joining sl st, sc in each dc and dc in each sc around, join, **turn.**

Rnds 19-21: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join, **do not turn.** At end of last rnd, fasten off.

Bib

Row 1: Count back 14 sts from joining sl st on last rnd of Body, join mint green with sc in 14th st, dc in next st, (sc in next st, dc in next st) 13 times, turn. (28 sts made)

Rows 2-12: Ch 1, sc in each dc and dc in each sc across, turn. At end of last row, fasten off.

Row 13: Join mint green with sc in same st as first st of row 1, evenly space 15 sts across ends of rows to last row, 3 sc in first st, sc in each st across to last st, 3 sc in last st, evenly space 15 sc across ends of rows, sc in same at as last st of row 1. Fasten off.

Strap (make 2)

Row 1: With mint green, ch 43, sc in second ch from hook, dc in next ch, (sc in next ch, dc in next ch) across, turn. (42 sts made)

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each dc and dc in each sc across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each st across; for **button loop**, ch 4, skip end of rows 1 and 2; working in remaining lps on opposite side of starting ch, sc in each st across. Fasten off. Sew straight end of each Strap to top edge of Body about 2 1/2" from side edges of Bib. Sew one button to each top corner of Bib.

T-SHIRT Neckband

Row 1: With cream, ch 6, sc in second ch from hook, sc in each ch across, turn. {5 sc made)

Rows 2-49: Working these rows in **back lps** (see Stitch Guide), ch 1, sc in each st across, turn. At end of last row, **do not turn or fasten off.**

Body

Row 1: Working in ends of rows across edge of Neckband, ch 1, 2 sc in first row, (sc in next row, 2 sc in next row) across, turn. (74 sts made)

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first st, dc in next st, (sc, dc) in each of next 2 sts, *sc in next st, dc in next st, (sc, dc) in each of next 2 sts; repeat from * 16 more times, sc in next st, dc in last st, turn. (110sts)

Rows 3-6: Ch 1. sc in each dc and dc in each sc across, turn,

Row 7: Ch 1, sc in each dc and dc in each sc across; matching last dc with fourth dc of row, lap last 4 sts of row 7 over first 4 sts; turn.

Rnd 8: Working through both thicknesses, sl st in first st, ch 1, sc in same st, dc in next st, sc in next st, dc in next st; working in remaining sts of row 7, (sc in next st, dc in next st) around, join with sl st in first sc, **turn.** (106 sts)

Rnd 9: Ch 1, skip joining sl st, sc in each dc and dc in each sc around, join with sl st in first sc, **turn.**

Row 10: For **top of armhole**, sl st in first 8 sts; for **front**, (sl st, ch 1, sc) in next st, dc in next st, * (sc, dc) in each of next 2 sts. (sc in next st, dc in next st) 4 times; repeat from * 2 more times, (sc, dc) in each of next 2 sts, sc in next st, dc in next st, (sc, dc) in next st leaving remaining sts unworked, turn. (46 sts)

Rows 11-14: Ch 1, sc in each dc and dc in each sc across, turn. At end of last row, fasten off.

Row 10: For **top of armhole**, skip next 16 unworked sts on rnd 9; for **back**, join cream with sc in next st, dc in next st, *(sc, dc) in each of next 2 sts, (sc in next st, dc in next st) 4 times; repeat from * 2 more times, (sc, dc) in each of next 2 sts, sc in next st, dc in next st, (sc, dc) in next st, leaving last 8 sts unworked for **top of armhole**, turn. (46 sts)

Rows 11-14: Ch 1, sc in each dc and dc in each sc across, turn. At end of last row, **do not fasten off**.

Rnd 15: Ch 1, sc in each dc and dc in each sc across back, ch 8 for **bottom of armhole**; sc in each dc and dc in each sc across front, ch 8 for **bottom of armhole**, join with sl st in first sc, **turn**. (92 sts, 16 chs)

Rnd 16: Ch 1, skip joining sl st; working in chs and in sts, (sc in next st, dc in next st) around, join, **turn**. (108 sts)

Rnds 17-25: Ch 1. skip joining sl st. sc in each dc and dc in each sc around, join, **turn**. At end of last rnd, fasten off.

Sleeves

Rnd 1: Join cream with sc in fourth ch of ch-8 at bottom of one armhole, sc in next 3 chs, sc next ch and end of next row tog, sc in end of next 4 rows, sc end of next row and next unworked st of rnd 9 tog, sc in next 14 sts, sc next st and next end of row tog. sc in next 4 rows, sc next row and next ch tog, sc in last 2 chs, join with sl st in first sc, **turn**. {32 sc made}

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in first st, dc in next st, (sc in next st, dc in next st) around, join, **turn**.

Rnds 3-12: Ch 1, skip joining sl st, sc in each dc and dc in each sc around, join. **turn**. At end of last rnd, fasten off.

Repeat on other armhole.

CAP

Rnd 1: With mint green, ch 4, sl st in first ch to form ring, ch 1, 8 sc in ring, join with sl st in first sc. (8 sc made)

Rnd 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in each st around, join. (16 sc)

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in first, st, 2 sc in next st, (sc in next st, 2 sc in next st) around, join. (24 sc)

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in first 2 sts, 2 sc in next st, (sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st) around, join. (32 sc)

Rnd 5: Ch 1, 2 sc in first st, sc in next 3 sts, (2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts) around, join. (40 sc)

Rnd 6: Ch 1, sc in first 4 sts, 2 sc in next st, (sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st) around, join. (48 sc)

Rnds 7-8: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Rnd 9: Ch 1, sc in first 5 sts, 2 sc in next st, (sc in next 5 sts. 2 sc in next st) around, join. (56 sc)

Rnds 10-11: Ch 1. sc in each st around, join.

Rnd 12: Ch 1, 2 sc in first st, sc in next 6 sts, (2 sc in next st, sc in next 6 sts) around, join. (64 sc)

Rnd 13: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Rnd 14: Ch 1, sc in first 7 sts. 2 sc in next st, (sc in next 7 sts, 2 sc in next st) around, join. (72 sc)

Rnd 15: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

NOTES: To change colors (see illustration).



Drop first color, with second color, work off last 2 lps of st. When changing colors, drop unused color to wrong side of work and pick up when needed.

Rnd 16: Ch 1, sc in first 35 sts changing to cream in last st made (see Note), sc in next 2 sts changing to mint green in last st made, sc in last 35 sts, join.

Rnd 17: Ch 1, sc in first 8 sts, 2 sc in next st, (sc in next 8 sts, 2 sc in next st) 2 times, sc in next 7 sts changing to cream in last st made, sc in next 4 sts changing to mint green in last made, sc in next 7 sts, (2 sc in next st, sc in next 8 sts) 3 times, join. (78 sc)

Rnd 18: Ch 1, sc in first 36 sts changing to cream in last st made, sc in next 6 sts changing to mint green in last st made, sc in last 36 sts, join.

Rnd 19: Ch 1, sc in first 8 sts, 2 sc in next st, (sc in next 8 sts, 2 sc in next st) 2 times, sc in next 8 sts changing to cream in last st made, sc in next 8 sts changing to mint green in last st made, sc in next 8 sts, (2 sc in next st, sc in next 8 sts) 3 times, join. (84 sc)

Rnds 20-22: Ch 1, sc in first 37 sts changing to cream in last st made, sc in next 10 sts changing to mint green in last st made, sc in last 37 sts, join. At end of last rnd, fasten off.

Bill Side (make 1 mint green, 1 cream)

Row 1: Ch 35, sc in second ch from hook, sc in each ch across, turn. (34sc made)

Row 2: Ch 1, skip first st, (sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st) 5 times, sc in next 2 sts leaving last st unworked, turn. (37 sc)

Rows 3-4: Ch 1, skip first st, sc in each st across leaving last st unworked, turn. (35 sc, 33 sc)

Row 5: Sl st in first st, ch 1, skip next st, (sc in next 6 sts, 2 sc in next st) 4 times, sl st in next st leaving last 2 sts unworked, turn. (33 sts)

Rows 6-7: Ch 1, skip sl st and first sc, sc in each st across to last 2 sts, sl st in next st, skip last st, turn. (30 sts, 27sts)

Row 8: Ch 1, skip sl st and first sc, (sc in next 6 sts, 2 sc in next st) 3 times, sc in next st, sl st in next st, skip last 2 sts, turn. (26 sts)

Rows 9-10: Ch 1, skip sl st and first sc, sc in each st across to last 3 sts, sl st in next st, skip last 2 sts. turn. At end of last row, fasten off. (18 sts)

For **Bill Form**, using one crochet piece as a pattern, trace and cut piece from acrylic or plastic.

Matching curved edges, hold both Bill Sides together, with green piece facing you; working through both thicknesses, join mint green with sc in end of row 1, sc in end of each row and in each st across to opposite end of row 1, insert Form inside Bill, sl st in each remaining lp of starting ch. Fasten off.

Sew straight edges centered across front of Cap.

Sew one button to center top of Cap.

BOOTIE (make 2)

Rnd 1: With mint green, ch 11, 2 hdc in third ch from hook, hdc in next 7 chs, 5 hdc in last ch; working in remaining lps on opposite side of starting ch, hdc in next 7 chs, 1 hdc

in last ch, join with sl st in top of ch-2. (23 hdc made)

Rnd 2: Ch 2, 2 hdc in each of next 2 sts, hdc in next 8 sts, 2 hdc in each of next 3 sts, hdc in next 9 sts, 2 hdc in last st, join. (30 hdc)

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in first 2 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts, hdc in next 6 sts, 2 hdc in each of next 2 sts, hdc in next st, 2 hdc in each of next 2 sts, hdc in next 6 sts, sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in last st. join with sl st in first sc. (36 sts)

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in first 3 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 6 sts, hdc in next 5 sts, (2 hdc in next st, hdc in next st) 4 times, hdc in next 4 sts, sc in next 7 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in last st, join. (42 sts)

Rnd 5: Working this rnd in **back lps**, ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Rnds 6-8: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Rnd 9: Ch 1, sc in first 9 sts, (dc next 2 sts tog) 3 times, (tr next 3 sts tog) 4 times, (dc next 2 sts tog) 3 times, sc in last 9 sts, sc in joining sl st, join. (29 sts)

Rnd 10: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Rnd 11: Ch 3, dc in each st around, join with sl st in top of ch-3.

Rnd 12: Working from left to right, ch 1, **reverse sc** (see Stitch Guide) in each st around, join with sl st in first st. Fasten off.

Drawstring

With mint green, ch until piece measures 9" long. Fasten off. Beginning at center front, weave Drawstring through sts of rnd 11, going over one and under one. Tie ends of Drawstring in a bow.

BRACELET

Spell "CHRIS" or desired name with alphabet beads and string beads on 4" piece elastic cord; add amount of spacer beads needed to fit around doll's wrist on cord. Wrap Bracelet around wrist and tie ends of cord together. Trim off excess ends of cord.

FINISHING

Sew snaps evenly spaced across shoulder opening on T-Shirt.

Tack or glue wings to center back of T-Shirt about 1" from neck edge.

Place Overalls, T-Shirt, Cap, Booties and Bracelet on doll.

BRANDEE

(Shown on front cover at right.)

FINISHED SIZE:

1 peach ribbon flower

1 yd. of peach 1/8" ribbon

13" of white Elastic Cord #1125-66 by Darice
2 small snaps
3/4" pin back
Off-white sewing thread
Craft glue
Tapestry and sewing needles
No. 7 steel hook or hook needed to obtain gauge

GAUGE:

8 sts = 1"; 10 dc and hdc pattern rows = 2".

BASIC STITCHES:

Ch, sl st, sc, hdc, dr., tr.

GOWN

Row 1: With ivory, ch 45. sc in second ch from hook, sc in each ch across, turn. (44 sc made)

Row 2: (Ch 2, hdc) in first st, 2 hdc in each st across, turn. (88 hdc)

Row 3: Working this row in **back lps** (see Stitch Guide), ch 2, hdc in each st across, turn.

Row 4: Ch 3, dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc in next st, (dc, in next 3 sts. 2 dc in next st) across, turn. (110 dc)

Row 5: Ch 2, hdc in each st across, turn.

Row 6: Ch 3, dc in each st across, turn.

Row 7: Ch 2, hdc in each st across, turn.

Row 8: Ch 3, dc in next 4 sts, (2 dc in next st, dc in next 6 sts) across, turn. (125 dc)

Row 9: Ch 2, hdc in each st across, turn.

Row 10: Ch 3, dc in next 19 sts; for **armhole**, ch 20, skip next 16 sts; dc in next 53 sts; for **armhole**, ch 20, skip next 16 sts; dc in last 20 sts, turn. (93 dc, 40 chs)

Row 11: Ch 2, hdc in each st and in each ch across, turn. (133 hdc)

Row 12: Ch 3, dc in next 2 sts, (2 dc in next st, dc in next 9 sts) across, turn. (146 dc)

Row 13: Ch 2, hdc in each st across, turn.

Row 14: Ch 3, dc in next 5 sts, (2 dc in next st, dc in next 9 sts) across, turn. (160 dc)

Row 15: Ch 2, hdc in each st across, turn.

Row 16: Ch 3, dc in next 8 sts, 2 dc in next st, (dc in next 9 sts. 2 dc in next st) across, turn. (176 dc)

Row 17: Ch 2, hdc in each st across: matching last st with fourth st of row, lap last 4 sts of row 17 over first 4 sts; turn.

Rnd 18: Working through both thicknesses, sl st in first st, ch 3, dc in next 3 sts; working in remaining sts of row 17, dc in each st around. join with sl st in top of ch-3, **turn.** (172dc)

Rnd 19: Ch 2, hdc in each st around, join with sl st in top of ch-2, **turn.**

Rnd 20: Ch 3, dc in each st around, join, **turn.**

Rnds 21-33: Repeat rnds 19 and 20 alternately, ending with rnd 19.

Rnd 34: Working this rnd in **back lps**, ch 3, dc in each st around, join. Fasten off.

Bottom Lace Trim

Rnd 1: Working in remaining **front lps** of rnd 33 behind last rnd of Gown. join variegated with sl st in first st, ch 5, skip next 2 sts, (dc in next st, ch 2, skip next 2 sts) around to last st, skip last st, join with sl st in third ch of ch-5. (57 dc and 57 ch sps made)

Rnd 2: Ch 5, skip next ch sp, (dc in next dc, skip next ch sp) around, join.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in first st, sc in next ch sp, (skip next ch sp, 8 dc in next ch sp, skip next ch sp, sc in next ch sp) around, join with sl st in first sc,

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in first st, ch 3, (sc, ch 3) in each st around, join. Fasten off.

Sleeves

Rnd 1: Join ivory with sc in 11th ch of ch-20 at bottom of one armhole, sc in next 8 chs, sc next ch and side of next sc tog; working in skipped sts of row 9, dc in next 2 sts, (2 dc in next st, dc in next st) 7 times, sc side of next sc and next ch tog, sc in last 9 chs, join with sl st in first sc, turn. (43 sts made)

Rnd 2: Ch 2, hdc in each st around to last st, skip last st, join with sl st in top of ch-2, turn. (42 hdc)

Rnd 3: Ch 3, dc in each st around to last st, skip last st, join with sl st in top of ch-3, turn. (41 dc)

Rnds 4-12: Repeat rnds 2 and 3 alternately, ending with rnd 2 and 30 hdc. At end of last rnd, fasten off.

Repeat on other armhole.

Lace Shell

Row 1: Working in remaining **front lps** of row 2 on Gown, skip first 4 sts, join variegated with sc in next st, sc in each st across, turn. (84 sc made)

Row 2: Ch 5 (counts, as first dc and ch sp), skip next st, dc in next st, (ch 2, skip next st, dc in next st) across to last st, ch 2, dc in last st, turn. (43 dc, 42 ch sps)

Row 3: Ch 5, skip next ch sp, dc in next st, (ch 2, skip next ch sp, dc in next st) across, turn.

NOTE: For **double crochet cluster (dc cluster)**, *yo, insert hook in st or ch. yo, pull lp through, yo, pull through 2 lps on hook leaving last lps on hook; working in same st or ch, repeat from * number of times needed for number of dc in cluster, yo and pull through all lps on hook.

Row 4: Skipping ch sps, ch 5, * dc in next st, ch 4, **2-dc cluster** (see Note) in fourth ch from hook, 3-dc cluster in next st, ch 4, 2-dc cluster in fourth ch from hook, dc in next st, ch 2; repeat from * across leaving ch-2 of last repeat unworked, turn. (14 3-dc clusters, 29 dc)

Row 5: Ch 5, * (3-dc cluster, ch 2, 3-dc cluster) in next 3-dc cluster, (ch 2, dc in next dc) 2 times, ch 2; repeat from * across leaving last ch-2 of last repeat unworked, turn. (28 clusters, 29 dc)

Row 6: Ch 5, dc in next st, ch 2, (dc, ch 2) in each cluster and in each st across to last st, (dc, ch 2, dc) in last st, turn. (58 dc)

Row 7: Ch 5, dc: in next st, (ch 2, dc in next st) across, turn.

Rows 8-9: Repeat rows 4 and 5. (38 clusters, 39 dc)

Row 10: Ch 5, dc in next st, (ch 2, dc in next cluster or st) 8 times, ch 2, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next cluster; for **armhole**, ch 20, skip next 19 clusters and sts, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next cluster, * ch 2, dc in next cluster or st, ch 2, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next cluster or st; repeat from * 7 more times; for **armhole**, ch 20, skip next 19 clusters and sts; (dc, ch 2, dc) in next cluster, (ch 2, dc in next st or cluster) 10 times, turn.

Rnd 11: Working in rnds, ch 5, dc in next st, (ch 2, dc in next st) 10 times, (ch 2, skip next 2 chs, dc in next ch) 6 times, ch 2, skip next 2 chs, (dc in next st, ch 2) 25 times, dc in next st, (ch 2, skip next 2 chs, dc in next ch) 6 times, ch 2, skip next 2 chs, (dc in next st, ch 2) 12 times, join with sl st in third ch of ch-5, **turn**.

Rnd 12: Ch 5, *dc in next st, ch 4, 2-dc cluster in fourth ch from hook, 3-dc cluster in next st, ch 4, 2-dc cluster in fourth ch from hook, dc in next st, ch 2; repeat from * around to last st, dc in last st, ch 2, join with sl st in third ch of ch-5, **turn**.

Rnd 13: Ch 5, dc in next st, ch 2, dc in next st, * (3-dc cluster, ch 2, 3-dc cluster) in next 3-dc cluster, (ch 2, dc in next st) 2 times, ch 2, repeat from * around to last 3-dc cluster, (3-dc cluster, ch 2, 3-dc cluster) in next 3-dc cluster, ch 2, dc in next st, ch 2, join, **turn**.

Rnd 14: Ch 5, dc in next st, (ch 2, dc) in each st and in each cluster around, ch 2, join, **turn**.

Rnd 15: Ch 5, dc in next st, (ch 2, dc) in each st around, ch 2, join, **do not turn**.

Rnd 16: Sc in first ch sp, (skip next ch sp, 8 dc in next ch sp, skip next ch sp, sc in next ch sp) around to last st and ch sp, ch 3, sc in next st, ch 3, sc in last ch sp, ch 3, sc in joining sl st of last rnd, **do not join**.

Rnd 17: Ch 3, sc in first st, ch 3, (sc, ch 3) in each st around, join with sl st in first ch of first ch-3 at end of rnd 16. Fasten off.

PANTIES Side (make 2)

Row 1: With ivory, ch 46, sc in second ch from hook, sc in each ch across, turn. (45 sc made)

Row 2: Ch 2, hdc in next st, 2 hdc in next st, (hdc in next 2 sts, 2 hdc in next st) across, turn, (60 hdc)

Row 3: Ch 3, dc in next 3 sts, 2 dc in next st, (dc in next 3 sts, 2 dc in next st) across, trnr. (75 dc)

Row 4: (Ch 2, hdc) in first st, hdc in each st across to last st, 2 hdc in last st, turn. (77 hdc)

Row 5: (Ch 3, dc) in first st, dc in each st across to last st, 2 dc in last st, turn. (79 dc)

Rows 6-7: Repeat rows 4 and 5. (81 hdc, 83 dc)

Row 8: Sl st in first 5 sts for front shaping; ch 1, hdc in each st across to last 11 sts, hdc next 2 sts tog leaving last 9 sts unworked for back shaping, turn. (68 hdc)

Row 9: Ch 2, dc in each st across to last 2 sts, dc last 2 sts tog, turn. (66 dc)

Row 10: Ch 1. skip first st, hdc in each st across to last 2 sts, hdc last 2 sts tog, turn. (64 hdc)

Rows 11-12: Repeat rows 9 and 10. (62 dc. 60 hdc)

Row 13: Ch 3, dc in each st across, turn.

Row 14: Ch 2, hdc in each st across, turn.

Rows 15-17: Repeat rows 13 and 14, ending with row 13. At end of last row, fasten off.

On each Side piece, match ends of rows 1—8 and sew together, forming inseam.

Matching front edges and back edges, sew Side pieces together.

Tack or tie ends of 9" piece elastic cord together.

For **waistband**, covering elastic cord as you work (see Stitch Guide), join ivory with sc in first st at center back seam on top of Panties, sc in each st around, join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

BOOTIE (make 2)

Rnd 1: With ivory, ch 11, 2 hdc in third ch from hook, hdc in next 7 chs, 5 hdc in last ch; working in remaining lps on opposite side of starting ch, hdc in next 7 chs, 2 hdc in last ch, join with sl st in top of ch-2. (23 hdc made)

Rnd 2: Ch 2, 2 hdc in each of next 2 sts, hdc in next 8 sts. 2 hdc in each of next 3 sts, hdc in next 9 sts, 2 hdc in last st, join. (30 hdc)

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in first 2 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts, hdc in next 6 sts, 2 hdc in each of next 2 sts, hdc in next st, 2 hdc in each of next 2 sts, hdc in next 6 sts, sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in last st, join with sl st in first sc. (36 sts)

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in first 3 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 6 sts, hdc in next 5 sts, (2 hdc in next st. hdc in next st) 4 times, hdc in next 4 sts, sc in next 7 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in last st, join. (42 sts)

Rnd 5: Working this rnd in **back lps**, ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Rnds 6-8: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Rnd 9: Ch 1, sc in first 9 sts, (dc next 2 sts tog) 3 times, (tr next 3 sts tog) 4 times, (dc next 2 sts tog) 3 times, sc in last 9 sts, sc in joining sl st, join. (29 sts)

Rnd 10: Ch 1, sc in each st around. join.

Rnd 11: Ch 3, dc in each st around, join with sl st in top of ch-3.

Rnd 12: Working from left to right, ch 1, **reverse sc** (see Stitch Guide) in each st around, join with sl st in first st. Fasten off.

Beginning at center front, weave a 10" piece of peach ribbon through sts of rnd 11, going over one and under one. Tie ends of ribbon in a bow. Trim ends to desired length.

BRACELET

Spell "BRANDEE" or desired name with alphabet beads and string beads on 4" piece elastic cord; add amount of spacer beads needed to fit around doll's wrist on cord. Wrap Bracelet around wrist and tie ends of cord together. Trim off excess ends of cord.

BARRETTE

Fold a 2" piece of peach ribbon in half, forming a V shape, glue fold to center of pin back. Glue ribbon flower to pin back. Place Barrette in doll's hair as desired.

FINISHING

Sew snaps evenly spaced down front opening of Gown.

Inserting ends through sps of Lace Shell, tack or glue wings to center back of Gown about 1" from top edge.

Insert Sleeves on Gown through arm-hole openings of Lace Shell.

Place Gown, Panties, Booties and Bracelet on doll.

GAUGE:

8 sts = 1": 7 hdc rows = 1".

BASIC STITCHES:

Ch, sl st, sc, hdc, dc, tr.

JUMPSUIT

Side (make 2)

Row 1: With white, ch 52, hdc in third ch from hook, hdc in each ch across to last ch, 2 hdc in last ch, turn. (52 hdc made)

Row 2: (Ch 2, hdc) in first st, hdc in each st across, turn. (53 hdc)

Row 3: Ch 2, hdc in each st across to last st, 2 hdc in last st, turn, (54 hdc)

Row 4: Ch 3, sc in second ch from hook, hdc in next ch, hdc in each st across to last st, 2 hdc in last st, **turn.** (57 sts)

Row 5: (Ch 2, 2 hdc) in first st, hdc in each st across to last st, 2 hdc in last st, turn. (60 hdc)

Row 6: Ch 4, sc in second ch from hook, hdc in next 2 chs, hdc in each st across to last st, 2 hdc in last st, turn. (64 sts)

Row 7: Ch 4, hdc in third ch from hook, hdc in next ch, hdc in each st across to last st, 2 sc in last st, turn. (68 sts)

Row 8: Ch 21, hdc in third ch from hook, hdc in next 18 chs, hdc in each st across to last st, 2 hdc in last st, turn. (89 hdc)

Row 9: Ch 2, hdc in next 31 sts; for **waistband**, sc in **back lp** (see Stitch Guide) of next 4 sts; working in **both lps**, hdc in each st across, turn.

Row 10: Ch 2, hdc in next 52 sts, sc in **back lp** of next 4 sts; working in **both lps**, hdc in each st across, turn.

Row 11: Ch 2, skip next st, hdc in each st across to waistband, sc in **back lp** of next 4 sts; working in **both lps**, hdc in each st across, turn. (88 sts)

Row 12: Ch 2, hdc in each st across to waistband, sc in **back lp** of next 4 sts; working in **both lps**, hdc in each st across to last 2 sts, hdc last 2 sts tog, turn. (87 sts)

Row 13: Ch 2, skip next st, hdc in each st across to waistband, sc in **back lp** of next 4 sts; working in **both lps**, hdc in each st across, turn. (86 sts)

Row 14: Ch 2, hdc in each st across to waistband, sc in **back lp** of next 4 sts; working in **both lps**, hdc in each st across, turn.

Rows 15-16: Repeat rows 13 and 14. (85 sts)

Row 17: Sl st in first 9 sts, sc in next st, hdc in next 18 sts, sc in **back lp** of next 4 sts, working in **both lps**, hdc in each st across, turn. (71 hdc, 5 sc, 9 sl sts)

Row 18: Ch 2, hdc in each st across to waistband, sc in **back lp** of next 4 sts; working in **both lps**, hdc in next 17 sts, sc next 2 sts tog leaving last 9 sl sts unworked, turn. (75 sts)

Row 19: Ch 1, sc first 2 sts tog. hdc in each st across to waistband, sc in **back lp** of next 4 sts; working in **both lps**, hdc in each sl across, turn. (74 sts)

Row 20: Ch 2, hdc in each st across to waistband, sc in **back lp** of next 4 sts; working in **both lps**, hdc in next 14 sts, sc next 2 sts tog leaving last st unworked, turn. (72 sts)

Row 21: Ch 1, sc first 2 sts tog, hdc in each st across to waistband, sc in **back lp** of next 4 sts; working in **both lps**, hdc in each st across, turn. (71 sts)

Row 22: Ch 2, hdc in each st across to waistband, sc in **back lp** of next 4 sts; working in **both lps**, hdc in next 13 sts leaving last st unworked, turn. (70 sts)

Row 23: Ch 2, hdc in each st across to waistband, sc in **back lp** of next 4 sts; working in **both lps**, hdc in each st across, turn.

Row 24: Ch 2, hdc in each st across to waistband, sc in **back lp** of next 4 sts; working in **both lps**, hdc in each st across, turn.

Rows 25-27: Repeat rows 23 and 24, ending with row 23.

Row 28: Ch 2, hdc in each st across to waistband, sc in **back lp** of next 4 sts; working in **both lps**, hdc in next 12 sts, 3 hdc in last st, turn. (72 sts)

Row 29: (Ch 2, hdc) in first st, hdc in each st across to waistband, sc in **back lp** of next 4 sts; working in **both lps**, hdc in each st across, turn. (73 sts)

Row 30: Ch 2, hdc in each st across to waistband, sc in **back lp** of next 4 sts; working in **both lps**, hdc in each st across to last st, 2 hdc in last st, turn. (74 sts)

Row 31: Ch 10, hdc in third ch from hook, hdc in next 7 chs, hdc in each st across to waistband, sc in **back lp** of next 4 sts; working in **both lps**, hdc in each st across, turn. (83 sts)

Row 32: Ch 2, hdc in each st across to waistband, sc in **back lp** of next 4 sts; working in **both lps**, hdc in each st across to last st, 2 hdc in last st, turn. (84 sts)

Row 33: Ch 2, hdc in each st across to waistline, sc in **back lp** of next 4 sts; working in **both lps**, hdc in each st across, turn.

Row 34: Ch 2, hdc in each st across to waistline, sc in **back lp** of next 4 sts; working in **both lps**, hdc in each st across to last st, 2 hdc in last st, turn. (85 sts)

Row 35: (Ch 2, hdc) in first st, hdc in each st across to waistline, sc in **back lp** of next 4 sts; working in **both lps**, hdc in each st across, turn. (86 sts)

Row 36: Repeat row 34. (87 sts)

Rows 37-38: Ch 2, hdc in each st across to waistline, sc in **back lp** of next 4 sts; working in **both lps**, hdc in each st across, turn.

Row 39: Ch 2, skip next st, hdc in each st across to waistline, sc in **back lp** of next 4 sts; working in **both lps**, hdc in each st across, turn. (86 sts)

Row 40: Ch 2, hdc in each st across to waistline, sc in **back lp** of next 4 sts; working in

both lps, hdc in each st across to last 2 sts, hdc last 2 sts tog, turn. 185 sts)
Row 41: Ch 2, skip next st, hdc in each st across to waistline, sc in **back lp** of next 4 sts; working in **both lps**, hdc in next 28 sts, sc next 2 sts tog leaving remaining sts unworked. turn. (60 sts)

Row 42: Ch 2, hdc in each st across to waistline, sc in **back lp** of next 4 sts; working in **both lps**, hdc in each st across to last 2 sts, hdc last 2 sts tog, turn. (59 sts)

Row 43: Ch 2, skip next st, hdc in each st across to waistline, sc in **back lp** of next 4 sts; working in **both lps**, hdc in next 24 sts, dc in next 3 sts, dc last 2 sts tog, turn. (57 sts)

Row 44: Ch 3, dc in next 2 sts, hdc in each st across to waistline, sc in **back lp** of next 4 sts; working in **both lps**, hdc in each st across, turn.

Row 45: Ch 2, hdc in each st across to waistline, sc in **back lp** of next 4 sts; working in **both lps**, hdc in each st across, turn,

Row 46: Ch 2, hdc in next 26 sts, sc in next st. Leaving remaining sts unworked, fasten off.

Matching sts of rows 45 and 46 on each Side piece, sew edges together for center back seam.

Matching ends of rows 9-17 with ends of rows 31-39 on one Side piece, sew edges together for shoulder seam. Repeat on second Side piece.

Matching last ten sts at bottom half of starting ch on each Side piece, sew edges together for center front seam.

Matching ends of rows and unworked sts of last seven rows to first seven rows on one Side piece, sew edges together for crotch and inseam. Repeat on second Side piece.

Front Plackets And Neck Edging

Row 1: Working in remaining lps of starting ch on left front edge of Jumpsuit, join white with sl st in first unworked ch, ch 2, hdc in each ch across to last ch, 3 hdc in last ch; working around neckline, hdc in end of each row and in each skipped st around to starting ch on right front edge of Jumpsuit, 3 hdc in first unworked ch, hdc in each ch across, turn.

Row 2: Ch 2, hdc in each st across with 3 hdc in center st of each 3-hdc group. Fasten off.

Collar

Row 1: Starting at top right corner st of Neck Edging, skip first 4 sts; working in **back lps** only, join white with sl st in next st, ch 2, hdc in same st, 2 hdc in each st across to 4 sts from. top left corner st, turn. (68 hdc made)

Row 2: Ch 2, hdc in next st, (2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 2 sts) across, turn. (90 hdc)

Row 3: Ch 2, hdc in each st across, turn.

Row 4: Ch 2, hdc in next 8 sts, 2 hdc in next st, (hdc in next 9 sts, 2 hdc in next st) across, turn. (99 hdc)

Row 5: Ch 2, hdc in each st across. Fasten off.

Placket And Collar Edging

Working from left to right, join wine with sl st in first st of last row at bottom right corner of Front Placket, ch 1, **reverse sc** (see Stitch Guide) in each st across to end of row 1 on Collar. Fasten off.

Working across outer edge of Collar, join wine with sl st in opposite end of row 1, ch 1, reverse sc in end of each row and in each st across to first end of row 1. Fasten off.

Sleeve (make 2)

Row 1: With white, ch 22. hdc in third ch from hook, hdc in each ch across, turn. (21 hdc made)

Row 2: Ch 2, hdc in each st across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 2, hdc in each st across to last st, 2 hdc in last st, turn. (22 hdc)

Row 4: (Ch 2, hdc) in first st, hdc in each st across, turn. (23 hdc)

Rows 5-12: Repeat rows 3 and 4 alternately. At end of last row (31 hdc).

Rows 13-17: Ch 2, hdc in each st across, turn.

Row 18: Ch 2, hdc next 2 sts tog, hdc in each st across, turn. (30 hdc)

Row 19: Ch 2, hdc in each st across to last 2 sts, skip next st, hdc in last st. turn. (29 hdc)

Rows 20-26: Repeat rows 18 and 19 alternately, ending with row 18 and 22 sts.

Rows 27-28: Ch 2, hdc in each st across, turn. At end of last row, fasten off.

Matching sts, sew first and last rows together, forming underarm seam.

Sew top curved edge of Sleeve to armhole on Jumpsuit, easing to fit.

Belt Loops

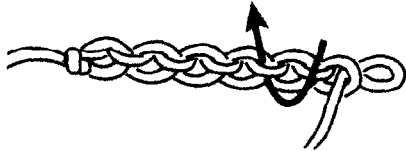
Working at center back of Jumpsuit for first Loop, join w/ine with sl st in first st above waistline, ch 6, sl st in first st below waistline. Fasten off.

Measuring 3" from first Loop, repeat on each side of Jumpsuit.

BELT

Row 1: With w/ine, ch until piece measures 12"; working in **back bar** of ch (see illustration), sc in second ch from hook, sc in each ch across, turn.

BACK BAR OF CHAIN



Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each st across to last st, 4 sc in last st. sl st in end of starting ch. Fasten off.

Place belt slide on Belt about 1 1/4" from rounded end. Sew one half of one snap to Belt behind belt slide. Sew other half of one snap to straight end of Belt.

BOOTIE (make 2]

Rnd 1: With white, ch 11, 2 hdc in third ch from hook, hdc in next 7 chs, 5 hdc in last ch; working in remaining lps on opposite side of starting ch, hdc in next 7 chs, 2 hdc in last ch, join with sl st in top of ch-2. (23 hdc made)

Rnd 2: Ch 2, 2 hdc in each of next 2 sts, hdc in next 8 sts, 2 hdc in each of next 3 sts, hdc in next 9 sts, 2 hdn in last st, join. (30 hdc)

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in first 2 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts, hdc in next 6 sts, 2 hdc in each of next 2 sts, hdc in next st, 2 hdc in each of next 2 sts, hdc in next 6 sts, sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in last st, join with sl st in first sc. (36 sts)

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in first 3 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 6 sts, hdc in next 5 sts. (2 hdc in next st, hdc in next st) 4 times, hdc in next 4 sts, sc in next 7 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in last st. join. (42 sts)

Rnd 5: Working this rnd in **back lps**, ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Rnds 6-8: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Rnd 9: Ch 1, sc in first 9 sts, (dc next 2 sts tog) 3 times, (tr next 3 sts tog) 4 times, (dc next 2 sts tog) 3 times, sc in last 9 sts, sc in joining sl st, join. (29 sts)

Rnd 10: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Rnd 11: Ch 3, dc in each st around, join with sl st in top of ch-3.

Rnd 12: Working from left to right, ch 1, **reverse sc** (see Stitch Guide) in each st around, join with sl st in first st. Fasten off.

Drawstring

With white, ch until piece measures 9" long. Fasten off.

Beginning at center front, weave Drawstring through sts of rnd 11, going over one and under one. Tie ends of Drawstring in a bow.

BRACELET

Spell "TOMMY" or desired name with alphabet beads and string beads on 4" piece elastic cord; add amount of spacer beads needed to fit around doll's wrist on cord. Wrap Bracelet around wrist and tie ends of cord together. Trim off excess ends of cord.

FINISHING

Sew four snaps evenly spaced down front Plackets on Jumpsuit. Tack or glue wings to center back of Collar about 1" from neck edge. Place Jumpsuit, Belt, Booties and Bracelet on doll.
