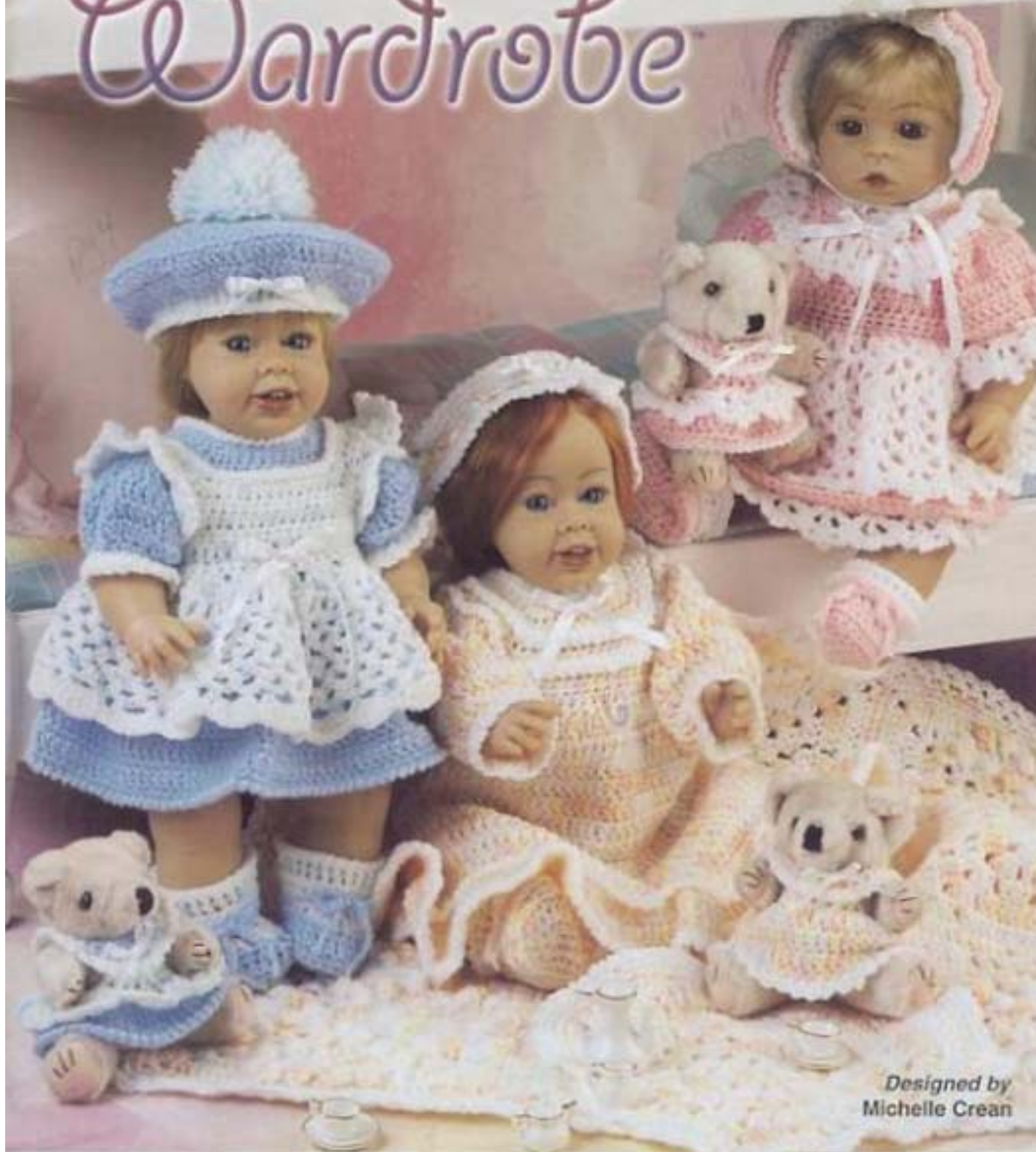

STITCH GUIDE

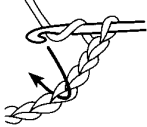
Half double crochet— hdc

Yo, insert hook in st, yo, pi through st, yo, pull through all 3 lps on hook.

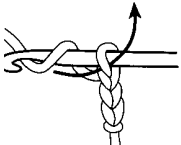


Double crochet—dc:

Yo, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, (yo, pull through 2 lps) 2 times.



Chain—ch: Yo, pull through lp on hook.



Single crochet—sc:

Insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, yo, pull through both lps on hook.

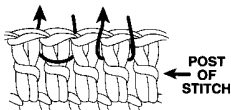


Front post stitch-fp:

Back post stitch-bp:

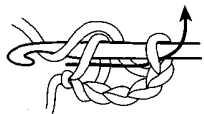
When working post st, insert hook from right to left around post of st on previous row.

BACK FRONT

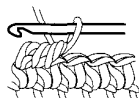
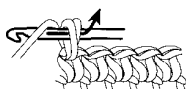
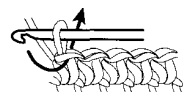


Slip stitch—sl st:

Insert hook in st, yo, pull through st and lp on hook.



Reverse sc: Working from left to right, insert hook in next st to the right, complete as sc.

FIRST DAY AT SCHOOL

(Shown on front cover at left.)

FINISHED SIZES:

Baby clothes fit 14" doll.
Bear clothes fit a 4" bear.

MATERIALS:

Jamie® Pompadour Art. #890 by Lion Brand Yarn Co. or pompadour baby yarn:
2 1/2 oz. Pastel Blue #206
2 oz. White #200
2 oz. variegated pompadour baby yarn
16" white W ribbon
6" white 1/8" ribbon
3 white 3/8" buttons
2 1/2" piece cardboard
Sewing thread and needle
D hook or hook needed to obtain gauge

GAUGE:

5 dc = 1"; 1 sc and 2 dc rows = 1".

BASIC STITCHES:

Ch, sl st, sc, hdc, dc.

BABY'S DRESS

Row 1: Starting at bodice, with blue, ch 37, hdc in third ch from hook, hdc in each of next 2 chs, (3 hdc in next ch, dc in next 8 chs) 3 times, 3 hdc in next ch, hdc in last 4 chs, turn. (44 hdc made)

Row 2: (Sc, ch 1) in first st (beg hdc made), hdc in next 4 sts, (3 hdc in next st, hdc in next 10 sts) 3 times, 3 hdc in next st, hdc in last 5 sts, turn.(52)

Row 3: Beg hdc in first st, hdc in next 5 sts, (3 hdc in next st, hdc in next 12 sts) 3 times, 3 hdc in next st, hdc in last 6 sts, turn. (60)

Row 4: Beg hdc in first st, hdc in next 6 sts, (3 hdc in next st, hdc in next 14 sts) 3 times, 3 hdc in next st, hdc in last 7 sts, turn. (68)

Row 5: Beg hdc in first st, hdc in next 7 sts, (2 hdc, dc) in next st, 2 dc in each of next 16 sts, (dc, 2 hdc) in next st, hdc in next 16 sts, (2 hdc, dc) in next st, 2 dc in each of next 16 sts, (dc, 2 hdc) in next st, hdc in last 8 sts, turn. (108 sts)

Row 6: Beg hdc in first st, hdc in next 9 sts; for **armhole**, ch 4, skip next 34 sts; hdc in next 20 sts: for **armhole**, ch 4, skip next 34 sts; hdc in last 10 sts, turn.

Row 7: Beg hdc in first st, hdc in each st and in each ch across, turn. (48 hdc]

Row 8: Beg hdc in first st, hdc in each st across, turn.

Rows 9-10: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 11: For **skirt**, (sc, ch 2) in first st (beg dc made), dc in same st as beg dc, 2 dc in each st across, turn (96 dc)

Row 12: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Rnd 13: Working in mds, beg dc in first st, dc in each st around, join with sl st in top of beg dc.

Rnd 14: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 15: (Beg dc, dc) in first st, dc in each of next 2 sts, (2 dc in next st, dc in each of next 2 sts) around, join. (128)

Rnd 16: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Rnd 17: Beg dc in first st, dc in each st around, join.

Rnds 18-23: Repeat mds 16 and 17 alternately.

Rnd 24: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Rnd 25: Ch 1, reverse sc (see Stitch Guide) in each st around, join.
Fasten off.

Sleeve

Rnd 1: Working in chs and sts on armhole, skip first 2 chs, join blue with sc in next ch, sc in next ch, hdc in end of row 6, dc next 2 sts tog, dc in next 30 sts, dc next 2 sts tog, hdc in end of row 6, sc in each of last 2 chs, join with sl st in first sc. (38 sts made)

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sts, dc next 2 sts tog, dc in next 28 sts, dc next 2 sts tog, sc in each of last 3 sts, join. (36)

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sts, dc next 2 sts tog, dc in next 26 sts, dc next 2 sts tog, sc in each of last 3 sts, join. (34)

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sts, (dc next 2 sts tog) 14 times, sc in each of last 3 sts, join. (20)

Rnd 5: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join. Fasten off.

Rnd 6: Join white with sc in first st, sc in each st around, join.

Rnd 7: Ch 1, sc in first st, ch 2, (sc in next st, ch 2) around, join. Fasten off.
Repeat on remaining armhole.

Neck Trim

Row 1: Working in starting ch on opposite side of row 1, join blue with sc in first ch, sc in each ch across. Fasten off.

Row 2: Join white with sc in last sc on row 1, reverse sc in each st across, sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

Left Placket

Row 1: With right side facing you, join blue with sc in base of dc at bottom of left back opening; working in ends of rows, evenly space 18 more sc across, sl st in first ch on row 1, turn. (19 sc made)

Row 2: Ch 1, skip sl st, sc in first sc; (for **buttonhole**, ch 1, skip next st, sc in next 5 sts) 3 times, turn.

Row 3: Sl st in each st and in each ch across, sl st in ch-1 on last row. Fasten off.

Right Placket

Row 1: With right side facing you, join blue with sc in last ch at neck; working in ends of rows, evenly space 18 more sc across, sl st in base of last dc, turn. (19 sc made)

Row 2: Ch 1, skip sl st, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 3: Sl st in each st across, sl st in ch-1 on last row. Fasten off.

Sew buttons to Right Placket opposite buttonholes.

BABYS PINAFORE

Row 1: With variegated, ch 53, hdc in third ch from hook, hdc in next 4 chs, (3 hdc in next ch, hdc in next 12 chs) 3 times, 3 hdc in next ch, hdc in last 6 chs, turn. Fasten off. (60 hdc made) Front of row 1 is right side of work.

Row 2: Join white with beg hdc in first st, hdc in next 6 sts, (3 hdc in next st, hdc in next 14 sts) 3 times, 3 hdc in next st, hdc in last 7 sts, turn. Fasten off. (68)

Row 3: Join variegated with beg hdc in first st, hdc in next 7 sts, (2 hdc, dc) in next st, (skip next 2 sts, 5 dc in next st) 5 times, skip next st, (dc, 2 hdc) in next st, hdc in next 16 sts, (2 hdc, dc) in next st, skip next st, (5 dc in next st, skip next 2 sts) 5 times, (dc, 2 hdc) in next st, hdc in last 8 sts, turn. Fasten off.

Row 4: Join white with beg hdc in first st, hdc in next 9 sts, ch 2, sc in next st, [*sc in

next st, (ch 2, sc in next st) 4 times; repeat from * 4 more times, sc in next st, ch 2], hdc in next 20 sts, ch 2, sc in next st;
repeat between [], hdc in last 10 sts, turn. Fasten off.

Row 5: Join variegated with beg dc in first st, dc in next 9 sts; for **armhole**, ch 4, skip next 27 sc and next 6 ch-2 sps; dc in next 20 sts; for **armhole**, ch 4, skip next 27 sts and next 6 ch-2 sps; dc last 10 sts, rum. Fasten off. (40 dc, 8 chs)

Row 6: Join white with sc in first st, sc in each st and in each ch across, turn. Fasten off. (48 sc)

Row 7: Join variegated with beg dc in first st, skip next st, (5 dc in next st, skip next 2 sts) 15 times, dc in last st, turn. Fasten off.

Row 8: Join white with beg dc in first st, *dc in next st, (cb 1, dc in next st) 4 times; repeat from * across to last st, dc in last st, turn. Fasten off.

Row 9: Join variegated with beg hdc in first st, ch 1, *sc in next ch sp, (ch 3, sc in next ch sp) 3 times; repeat from * 13 more times, sc in next ch sp, (ch 3, sc in next ch sp) 3 times, ch 1, hdc in last st, turn. Fasten off.

Row 10: Join white with beg hdc in first st, ch 1, skip ch-1 sp and next st, sc in next ch-3 sp, (ch 3, sc in next ch-3 sp) across to next ch-1 sp, skip ch sp, hdc in last st, turn. Fasten off.

Row 11: Join variegated with beg hdc in first st, ch 1, sc in ch-1 sp, (ch 3, sc in next ch sp) across to last ch-1 sp, ch 3, sc in ch-1 sp, ch 1, hdc in last st, turn. Fasten off.

Rows 12-15; Repeat rows 10 and 11 alternately. **Do not turn** at end of last row.

Rnd 16: Working around outer edge, with right side facing you, join white with sc in first st, skip next ch sp and next st, 5 dc in next ch sp, (sc in next ch sp, 5 dc in next ch sp) across to last ch sp, skip next ch sp, sc in last st; working in ends of rows, ch 1, 3 sc in each of next 7 rows, 2 sc each of next 2 rows, sc in next row, 2 sc in next row, 3 sc in each of next 4 rows, ch 1; working in starting ch on opposite side of row 1, sc in each ch across, ch 1; working in ends of rows, 3 sc in each of next 4 rows, 2 sc in next row, sc in next row, 2 sc in each of next 2 rows, 3 sc in each of last 7 rows, ch 1, join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

For **tie**, with white, ch 25, sl st in ch-1 at neck edge, sl st in next 9 sts on back to waist, ch 25. Fasten off.

Repeat on other side of neck edge.

Tie a 10" piece of W ribbon in bow around center dc on row 5 at waist.

BABY'S SHOE [make 2]

Rnd 1: With blue, ch 6, (beg hdc, 2 hdc) in second ch from hook, sc in each of next 3 chs, 5 hdc in end ch;

working on opposite side of starting ch, sc in each of next 3 chs, 2 hdc in same ch as beg hdc, join with sl st in top of beg hdc. [16 sts made]

Rnd 2: (Beg hdc, hdc) in first st, hdc in each of next 2 sts, sc in each of next 3 sts, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next st, 3 hdc in next st, hdc in next st, 2 hdc in next st, sc in each of next 3 sts, hdc in each of last 2 sts, hdc in same st as beg hdc, join. (22)

Rnd 3: (Beg hdc, hdc) in first st, hdc in next 8 sts, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next st, 3 hdc in next st, hdc in next st, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 8 sts, hdc in same st as beg hdc, join. (28)

Rnd 4: Working in **back lps** (see Stitch Guide), ch 1, sc in each st around, join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, sc in first 10 sts, hdc in next 9 sts, sc in last 9 sts, join.

Rnd 6: Ch 1, sc in first 9 sts, (hdc next 2 sts tog, hdc in next st) 3 times, hdc next 2 sts tog, sc in last 8 sts, join. Fasten off. (24)

Rnd 7: Working in **back lps**, join white with sc in first st, sc in next 7 sts, (dc next 2 sts

tog) 2 times, dc in next st, (dc next 2 sts tog) 2 times, sc in last 7 sts, join. (20)

Rnds 8-9: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Rnd 10: Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sts, 2 sc in next st, (sc in each of next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st) around, join. (25)

Rnd 11: Working in **back lps**, ch 1, sc in each st around, join. Fasten off.

Rnd 12: Join variegated with sc in first st, ch 1, sc fp (see Stitch Guide) around each st around, join. Fasten off.

Rnd 13: Join white with sc in first st, sc fp around each st around, join.

Rnd 14: Sl st in each st around, join with sl st in first st. Fasten off.

For **ties**, with blue, ch 30, sl st around sc in center back on rnd 6, ch 30. Fasten off. Tie ends in bow on front.

BABY'S TAM

Rnd 1: With blue, ch 3, sl st in first ch to form ring, beg dc in ring, 11 dc in ring, join with sl st in top of beg dc.

(12 dc made)

Rnd 2: (Beg dc, dc) in first st, 2 dc in each st around, join. (24)

Rnds 3-4: Beg dc in first st, 2 dc in next st, (dc in next st, 2 dc in next st) around, join. (36, 54)

Rnd 5: Beg dc in first st, dc in next st, 2 dc in next st, (dc in each of next 2 sts, 2 dc in next st) around. (72)

Rnd 6: Beg dc in first st, dc in each of next 2 sts, 2 dc in next st, (dc in each of next 3 sts, 2 dc in next st) around, join. (90)

Rnd 7: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 8: Working in **back lps**, beg dc in first st, dc in each st around, join.

Rnd 9: Beg dc in first st, dc in each of next 2 sts, dc next 2 sts tog, (dc in each of next 3 sts, dc next 2 sts tog) around, join. (72)

Rnd 10: Ch 1, sc first 2 sts tog, sc in each next 2 sts, (sc next 2 sts tog, sc in each of next 2 sts) around, join. Fasten off. (54)

Rnd 11: Join variegated with sc in first st, sc fp around each st around, join.

Rnds 12-13: Ch 1, sc fp around each st around, join.

Rnd 14: Sl st in each st around, join with sl st in first sl st. Fasten off.

For **pom-pom**, wrap variegated 100 times around cardboard. Cut 18" piece and fold in half, tie around center of loops. **Do not trim** ends of tying strand. Holding ends of tying strand at bottom, cut loops and shape with bottom flat.

Pull ends of tie down through md 1 at top of Tam, tie ends in knot on underside to secure pom-pom.

Tie 6" piece 1/4" ribbon in bow around center front st on md 11.

BEAR'S DRESS

Row 1: Starting at neckline, with blue, ch 21, sc in second ch from hook, 2 sc in next ch, (sc in next ch, 2 sc in next ch) across, turn. Fasten off. (30 sc made)

Row 2: Working in **front lps**, join variegated with sc in first st, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 3: Working in **back lps**, ch 1, sc in next 14 sts, 2 sc in each of next 2 sts, sc in last 14 sts, turn. (32)

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in first 5 sts; for **armhole**, ch 5, skip next 8 sts; sc in next 6 sts; for **armhole**, ch 5, skip next 8 sts; sc in last 5 sts, turn.

Rnd 5: Working in rnds, ch 1, sc in each st and in each ch around, join with sl st in first sc. (26)

Rnd 6: Working in **front lps**, beg dc in first st, 4 dc in same st as beg dc, (skip next 2 sts, 5 dc in next st) 8 times, skip last st, join with sl st in top of beg dc.

Rnd 7: Ch 1, sc in first st, (ch 2, sc in next st) 4 times, *sc in next st, (ch 2, sc in next st) 4 times; repeat from * around, join.

Rnd 8: Ch 1, *sc in next ch sp, (ch 2, sc in next ch sp) 3 times, skip next 2 sts; repeat from * around, join. Fasten off.

Rnd 9: For **skirt**, working in remaining lps otmd 5, join blue with beg dc in first st, dc in same st as beg dc, 2 dc in each st around, join with sl st in top of beg dc.

Rnd 10: Beg dc in first st, dc in each st around, join.

Rnd 11: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Rnd 12: Ch 1, reverse sc (see Stitch Guide) in each st around, join. Fasten off.

Finishing

1: For **neck ruffle**, working in **remaining lps** on row 2, join white with sc in first st, (ch 2, sc in next st) across. Fasten off.

2: For **neckline**, working in ends of rows, join variegated with sc in end of first row on right side at back neck edge, sc in each row across, sl st in joining sl st on rnd 5, sc in end of each row across other back, sl st in starting ch. Fasten off.

3: For **tie**, with blue, ch 25; working in starting ch on opposite side of row 1 on bodice, sc in each ch across, ch 25. Fasten off.

4: Tie 1/8" ribbon in bow around center sc on row 2.

NIGHTEE & BLANKEE

(Shown on front cover at center.)

FINISHED SIZES:

Baby clothes fit 14" doll. Bear clothes fit a 4" bear.

MATEFILUS:

4 1/2 oz. White #200 Jamie® Pompadour Art. #890 by Lion Brand Yarn Co. or pompadour baby yarn

7 oz. variegated pompadour yarn

2 yds. white 1/4" ribbon

8" white 1/8" ribbon

2 white 3/8" buttons

Sewing thread and needle

Tapestry needle

D hook or hook needed to obtain gauge

GAUGE:

5 dc = 1"; 1 sc and 2 dc rows = 1".

BAS/C STITCHES:

Ch, sl st, sc, hdc, dc.

BABY'S NIGHTEE

Row 1: Starting at bodice, with variegated, ch 37, hdc in third ch from hook, hdc in each of next 2 chs, (3 hdc in next ch, dc in next 8 chs) 3 times, 3 hdc in next ch, hdc in last 4 chs, turn. (44 hdc made)

Row 2: (Sc, ch 1) in first st (beg hdc made), hdc in next 4 sts, (3 hdc in next st, hdc in next 10 sts) 3 times, 3 hdc in next st, hdc in last 5 sts, turn.(52)

Row 3: Working in **back lps** (see Stitch Guide), beg hdc in first st, hdc in next 5 sts, (3 hdc in next st, hdc in next 12 sts) 3 times, 3 hdc in next st, hdc in last 6 sts, turn. (60)

Row 4: Beg hdc in first st, hdc in next 6 sts, (3 hdc in next st, hdc in next 14 sts) 3 times, 3 hdc in next st, hdc in last 7 sts, turn. (68)

Row 5: Working in **back lps**, beg hdc in first st, hdc in next 7 sts, (2 hdc, dc) in next st, (2 dc in next st, hdc in next st) 8 times (top of Sleeve), (dc, 2 hdc) in next st, hdc in next 16 sts, (2 hdc, dc) in next st, (2 dc in next st, hdc in next st) 8 times, (dc, 2 hdc) in next st, hdc in last 8 sts, turn. (92 sts)

Row 6: Beg hdc in first st, hdc in next 9 sts; for **armhole**, ch 4, skip next 26 sts; hdc in next 20 sts; for **armhole**, ch 4, skip next 26 sts; hdc in last 10 sts, turn. (40 hdc, 8 chs)

Row 7: Beg hdc in first st, hdc in each st and in each ch across, turn. (48 hdc)

Row 8: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 9: Ch 1, (sc, ch 2) in first st (beg dc made), 2 dc in next st, (dc in next st, 2 dc in next st) across, turn. (72 dc)

Row 10: Beg dc in first st, dc in each st across, turn.

Rnds 11-15: Working in rnds, beg dc in first st, dc in each st around, join with sl st in top of beg dc.

Rnd 16: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 17: (Beg dc, dc) in first st, dc in each of next 2 sts, (2 dc in next st, dc in each of next 2 sts) around, join. (96)

Rnds 18-23: Beg dc in first st, dc in each st around, join. At end of last rnd, fasten off.

Rnd 24: Join white with sc in first st, sc in each st around, join. Fasten off.

Rnd 25: Working in **back lps**, join variegated with beg dc in first st, dc in same st as beg dc, 2 dc in each st around, join.

Rnds 26-27: Beg dc in first st, dc in each st around, join. At end of last rnd, fasten off.

Rnd 28: Join white with sc in first st, ch 2, (sc, ch 2) in each st around, join. Fasten off.

Rnd 29: Working in **remaining lps** on rnd 24, join white with sc in first st, ch 2, (sc, ch 2) in each st around, join. Fasten off.

Sleeve

Rnd 1: Working in chs and sts on arm-hole, join variegated with sc in second ch, sc in next ch, hdc in end of row 6, dc next 2 sts tog, dc in next 22 sts, dc next 2 sts tog, hdc in end of row 6, sc in last 2 chs, join with sl st in first sc. (30 sts made)

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sts, dc next 2 sts tog, dc in next 20 sts, dc next 2 sts tog, sc in each of last 3 sts, join. (28)

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sts, dc next 2 sts tog, dc in next 18 sts, dc next 2 sts tog, sc in each of last 3 sts, join. (26)

Rnds 4-7: Beg dc in first st, dc in each st around, join with sl st in top of beg dc.

Rnd 8: Beg dc in first st, dc next 2 sts tog, (dc in next st, dc next 2 sts tog) around to last 2 sts, dc in each of last 2 sts, join.

Rnd 9: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join. Fasten off.

Rnd 10: Join white with sc in first st, ch 2, (sc, ch 2) in each st around, join. Fasten off.

Rnd 11: For **ruffle**, working in remaining lps of rnd 4, join white with sc in first st, (ch 2, sc) in each st around, join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

Rnd 12: Repeat ruffle in **remaining lps** of rnd 2.
Repeat on remaining armhole.

Collar

Row 1: Working in starting ch on opposite side of row 1, join white with sc in first ch, sc in each ch across, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first st, (ch 2, skip next st, sc in next st) across to last st, sc in last st. Fasten off.

Left Placket

Row 1: Working in ends of rows, join variegated with sc in end of row 11, 2 sc in each dc row, sc in each sc row with 3 sc evenly spaced across hdc rows, sl st in starting ch at neck, turn. (18 sc made)

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first st; for **buttonhole**, ch 1, skip next st; sc in next 5 sts; for **buttonhole**, ch 1, skip next st; sc in each st across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sl st in each st and in each ch across. Fasten off.

Right Placket

Row 1: Working in ends of rows, join variegated with sc in last ch at neck, 3 sc evenly space across hdc rows, sc in ends of sc rows and 2 sc in end of each dc row, sl st in base of last dc, turn. (18 sc made)

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sl st in each st across. Fasten off.

Sew buttons to Right Placket opposite buttonholes.

Tie a 10" piece of 1/4" ribbon in a bow around center st on row 1 at neck.

BABY'S SLIPPER (make 2)

Rnd 1: With variegated, ch 6, (beg hdc, 2 hdc) in second ch from hook, sc in each of next 3 chs, 5 hdc in end ch; working on opposite side of starting ch, sc in each of next 3 chs, 2 hdc in same ch as beg hdc, join with sl st in top of beg hdc. (16 sts made)

Rnd 2: (Beg hdc, hdc) in first st, hdc in each of next 2 sts, sc in each of next 3 sts, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next st, 3 hdc in next st, hdc in next st, 2 hdc in next st, sc in each of next 3 sts, hdc in each of last 2 sts, hdc in same st as beg hdc, join. (22)

Rnd 3: (Beg hdc, hdc) in first st, hdc in next 8 sts, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next st, 3 hdc in next st, hdc in next st, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 8 sts, hdc in same st as beg hdc, join. (28)

Rnd 4: Working in **back lps**, ch 1, sc in each st around, join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, sc in first 10 sts, hdc in next 9 sts, sc in last 9 sts, join.

Rnd 6: Ch 1, sc in first 9 sts, (hdc next 2 sts tog, hdc in next st) 3 times, hdc next 2 sts tog, sc in last 8 sts, join. (24)

Rnd 7: Working in **back lps**, ch 1, sc in first 8 sts, (dc next 2 sts tog) 2 times, dc in next st, (dc next 2 sts tog) 2 times, sc in last 7 sts, join. (20)

Rnd 8: Ch 1, sc in first st, ch 1, skip next st, (sc in next st, ch 1, skip next st) around, join.

Rnd 9: Ch 1, sc in first st, sc in next ch sp, sc in next st, 2 sc in next ch sp, (sc in next st, sc in next ch sp, sc in next st, 2 sc in next ch sp) around, join.

Rnds 10-12: Ch 1, sc fp (see Stitch Guide) around each st around, join. At end of last rnd, fasten off.

Rnd 13: Join white with sc in first st, ch 2, (sc in next st, ch 2) around, join. Fasten off. Weave 12" piece of 1/4" ribbon through ch sps on rnd 8, tie ends in bow at front.

Headband

Rnd 1: With variegated, ch 56, sl st in first ch to form ring, beg hdc in first ch, ch 1, skip next ch, (hdc in next ch, ch 1, skip next ch) around, join with sl st in top of beg hdc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in each st and in each ch sp around, join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

Rnd 3: Join white with sc in any st, ch 2, (sc, ch 2) in each st around, join. Fasten off.

Rnd 4: Working in starting ch on opposite side of row 1, join variegated with sc in first ch at base of first hdc, sc in each ch sp and in base of each hdc around, join. Fasten off.

Rnd 5: Join white with sc in any st, ch 2, (sc, ch 2) in each st around, join. Fasten off.

Weave 20" piece of 1/4" ribbon through ch sps on md 1, tie ends in bow.

BABY'S BLANKEE

Motif A (make 5)

Rnd 1: With variegated, ch 3, sl st in first ch to form ring, (beg dc, 2 dc) in ring, ch 2, (3 dc in ring, ch 2) 3 times, join with sl st in top of beg dc. Fasten off.

NOTE: For popcorn (pc), 4 dc in next st, drop lp from hook, insert hook in first st of 4-dc group, pick up dropped lp, pull through st, ch 1.

Rnd 2: Join white with beg dc in any ch sp, (dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same ch sp as beg dc, dc in next st, **pc** (see Note), dc in next st, *(2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch sp, dc in next st, pc, dc in next st; repeat from * around, join. Fasten off.

Rnd 3: Join variegated with beg dc in any ch sp, (dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same ch sp as beg dc, * [dc in next st, pc, dc in each of next 3 sts, pc, dc in next st], (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch sp; repeat from * 2 more times; repeat between [], join. Fasten off.

Rnd 4: Join white with beg dc in any ch sp, (dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same ch sp as beg dc, *[dc in next st, pc, dc in next 7 sts, pc, dc in next st], (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch sp; repeat from * 2 more times; repeat between [], join. Fasten off.

Rnd 5: Join variegated with beg dc in any ch sp, (dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same ch sp as beg dc, * [dc in next st, pc, dc in next 11 sts, pc, dc in next st], (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch sp; repeat from * 2 more times; repeat between [], join. Fasten off.

Rnd 6: Join white with beg dc in any ch sp, (dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same ch sp as beg dc, *[dc in each of next 3 sts, pc, (dc in next 5 sts, pc) 2 times, dc in each of next 3 sts], (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch sp; repeat from * 2 more times; repeat between [], join. Fasten off.

Rnd 7: Join variegated with beg dc in any ch sp, (dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same ch sp as beg dc, *[dc in next 7 sts, pc, dc in next st, pc, dc in each of next 3 sts, pc, dc in next st, pc, dc in next 7 sts], (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch sp; repeat from * 2 more times; repeat between [], join. Fasten off.

Rnd 8: Join white with sc in any ch sp, ch 2, sc in same ch sp as first sc, sc in each st around with (sc, ch 2, sc) in each ch sp around, join. Fasten off.

Motif B (make 4)

Rnd 1: With white, ch 3, sl st in first ch to form ring, (beg dc, 2 dc) in ring, ch 2, (3 dc in ring, ch 2) 3 times, join with sl st in top of beg dc. Fasten off.

Rnd 2: Join variegated with beg dc in any corner ch sp, (dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same ch sp as beg dc, dc in next st, ch 1, skip next st, dc in next st, *(2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next corner ch sp, ch 1, dc in next st, ch 1, skip next st, dc in next st; repeat from * around, join. Fasten off.

Rnd 3: Join white with beg dc in any corner ch sp, (dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same ch sp as beg dc, *[dc in next st, ch 1, skip next st, dc in each of next 3 sts and chs, ch 1, skip next st, dc in next st], (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next corner ch sp; repeat from * 2 more times; repeat between [], join. Fasten off.

Rnd 4: Join variegated with beg dc in any corner ch sp, (dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same ch sp as beg dc, *[dc in next st, ch 1, skip next st, dc in next 7 sts and chs, ch 1, skip next st, dc in next st], (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next corner ch sp; repeat from * 2 more times; repeat between [], join. Fasten off.

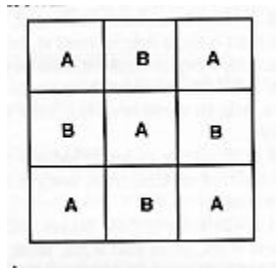
Rnd 5: Join white with beg dc in any corner ch sp, (dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same ch sp as beg dc, *[dc in next st, ch 1, skip next st, dc in next 11 sts and chs, ch 1, skip next st, dc in next st], (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next corner ch sp; repeat from * 2 more times; repeat between [], join. Fasten off.

Rnd 6: Join variegated with beg dc in any corner ch sp, (dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same ch sp as beg dc, *[dc in each of next 3 sts and chs, ch 1, skip next st, (dc in next 5 sts and chs, ch 1, skip next st) 2 times, dc in each of next 3 sts and chs], (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next corner ch sp; repeat from * 2 more times; repeat between [], join. Fasten off.

Rnd 7: Join white with beg dc in any corner ch sp, (dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same ch sp as beg dc, *[dc in next 7 sts and chs, ch 1, skip next st, dc in next st, ch 1, skip next st, dc in each of next 3 sts and chs, ch 1, skip next st, dc in next st, ch 1, skip next st, dc in next 7 sts and chs], (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next corner ch sp; repeat from * 2 more times; repeat between [], join. Fasten off.

Rnd 8: Join variegated with sc in any corner ch sp, ch 2, sc in same ch sp as first sc, sc in each st and in each ch-1 sp around with (sc, ch 2, sc) in each corner ch sp around, join. Fasten off.

Using variegated or white, sew Motifs right sides together according to illustration leaving corner ch sps.



Edging

Rnd 1: Working around entire outer edge, join variegated with sc in any corner ch sp, 2 sc in same corner ch sp as first sc, evenly space 90 more sc across to next corner ch sp, (3 sc in corner ch sp, evenly space 90 more sc across to next corner ch sp) around, join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

Rnd 2: Join white with sc in any center corner st, ch 2, skip next st, (sc in next st, ch 2, skip next st) around, join.

Rnd 3: (Sl st, ch 1, sc) in next ch sp, ch 3, (sc in next ch sp, ch 3) around, join. Fasten off.

BEAR'S DRESS

Row 1: With variegated, ch 21, sc in second ch from hook, 2 sc in next ch, (sc in next ch, 2 sc in next ch) across, turn. (30 sc made)

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 3: Working in **back lps**, ch 1, sc in next 14 sts, 2 sc in each of next 2 sts, sc in next 14 sts, turn. (32)

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in first 5 sts; for **armhole**, ch 5, skip next 8 sts; sc in next 6 sts; for **armhole**, ch 5, skip next 8 sts; sc in next 5 sts, turn.

Rnd 5: Working in rnds, ch 1, sc in each st and in each ch around, join with sl st in first sc. (26)

Rnd 6: Beg dc in first st, 2 dc in next st, (dc in next st, 2 dc in next st) around, join with sl st in top of beg dc.

Rnds 7-8: Beg dc in first st, dc in each st around, join.

Rnd 9: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Rnd 10: Join white with sc in first st, ch 3, (sc in next st, ch 3) around, join. Fasten off.

Rnd 11: Working in **remaining lps** on row 2, join white with sc in first st, (ch 1, sc) in each st across. Fasten off.

Finishing

1: For **plackets**, working in ends of rows on back opening, join variegated with sc in end of row on right side at back neck edge, sc in each row across, sl st in joining sl st, sc in each row, sl st in starting ch. Fasten off.

2: For **ties**, with white, ch 25; working in starting ch on opposite side of row 1 on Dress, sc in each ch across, ch 25. Fasten off.

3: Tie 1/8" ribbon in bow around center st on row 1 of Dress.

BEAR'S BLANKEE

Rnds 1-7: Work rnds 1-7 of Motif B on Baby's Blanke.

Rnd 8: Join variegated with sc in any corner ch sp, 2 sc in same ch sp, sc in each st and in each ch around with 3 sc in each corner ch sp, join. Fasten off.

Rnd 9: Join white with sc in any center corner st, 2 sc in same st as first sc, sc in each st around with 3 sc in each center corner st, join.

Rnd 10: Ch 1, sc in first st, ch 2, (sc, ch 2) in each st around, join. Fasten off.

BIRTHDAY PARTY DRESS

(Shown on front cover at right.)

FINISHED SIZES:

Baby clothes fit 14" doll. Bear clothes fit a 4" bear.

MATERIALS:

Red Heart® Baby Pompadour Art. E255 by Coats & dark or pompadour baby yarn:

1 1/2 oz. Lt. Pink #722

1 1/2 oz. White #1

40" white 1/4" ribbon

20" white 1/8" ribbon

3 white 3/8" buttons

Sewing thread and needle

Dhook or hook needed to obtain gauge

GAUGE:

5 dc = 1"; 1 sc and 2 dc rows = 1".

BASIC STITCHES:

Ch, sl st, sc, hdc, dc.

BABY'S DBESS

Row 1: Starting at bodice, with lt. pink, ch 37, hdc in third ch from hook, hdc in each of next 2 chs, (3 hdc in next ch, dc in next 8 chs) 3 times, 3 hdc in next ch, hdc in last 4 chs, turn. (44 hdc made)

Row 2: (Sc, ch 1) in first st (beg hdc made), hdc in next 4 sts, (3 hdc in next st, hdc in next 10 sts) 3 times, 3 hdc in next st, hdc in last 5 sts, turn. (52)

Row 3: Working in **front lps** (see Stitch Guide), beg hdc in first st, hdc in next 5 sts, (3 hdc in next st, hdc in next 12 sts) 3 times, 3 hdc in next st, hdc in last 6 sts, turn. (60)

Row 4: Beg hdc in first st, hdc in next 6 sts, (3 hdc in next st, hdc in next 14 sts) 3 times, 3 hdc in next st, hdc in last 7 sts, turn. (68)

Row 5: Beg hdc in first st, hdc in next 7 sts, (2 hdc, dc) in next st, 2 dc in each of next 16 sts, (dc, 2 hdc) in next st, hdc in next 16 sts, (2 hdc, dc) in next st, 2 dc in each of next 16 sts, (dc, 2 hdc) in next st, hdc in last 8 sts, turn. (108 sts)

Row 6: Beg hdc in first st, hdc in next 9 sts; for **armhole**, ch 4, skip next 34 sts; hdc in next 20 sts: for **armhole**, ch 4, skip next 34 sts; hdc in last 10 sts, turn.

Row 7: Beg hdc in first st, hdc in each st and in each ch across, turn. (48 hdc)

Row 8: Beg hdc in first st, hdc in each st across, turn.

Rows 9-10: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 11: For **underskirt**, working in **back lps**, ch 1, (sc, ch 2) in first st (beg dc made), dc in same st, 2 dc in each st across, turn. (96)

Row 12: Beg dc in first st, dc in each st across, turn.

Rnds 13-18: Working in rnds, beg dc in first st, dc in each st around, join with sl st in top of beg dc.

Rnd 19: Ch 1, sc in each of first 2 sts, 2 sc in next st, (sc in each of next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st) around, join with sl st in first sc. (128)

Rnd 20: Working in **front lps**, beg dc in first st, dc in each st around, join.

Rnd 21: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join. Fasten off.

Rnd 22: Working in **remaining lps** of md 19, join white with sl st in first st, (ch 5, dc, ch 2, dc) in same st as sl st, *skip next 3 sts, (dc, ch 2, dc, ch 2, dc) in next st; repeat from * around, join with sl st in third ch of beg ch-5.

Rnd 23: (Sl st, ch 1, sc) in first ch sp, *[ch 3, (sc; for **picot**, **ch 3**, **sl st in top of last st made**) in next st, ch 3], sc in each of next 2 ch sps; repeat from * 22 more times; repeat between [], sc in next ch sp, join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

Sleeve

Rnd 1: Working in chs, ends of rows and in sts on armhole, skip first 2 chs, join lt. pink with sc in next ch, sc in next ch, hdc in end of row 6, dc next 2 sts tog, dc in next 30 sts, dc next 2 sts tog, hdc in end of row 6, sc in each of last 2 chs, join with sl st in first sc. (38 sts made)

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sts, dc next 2 sts tog, dc in next 28 sts, dc next 2 sts tog, sc in each of last 3 sts, join. (36)

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sts, dc next 2 sts tog, dc in next 26 sts, dc next 2 sts tog, sc in each of last 3 sts, join. (34)

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sts, (dc next 2 sts tog) 14 times, sc in each of last 3 sts, join. (20)

Rnd 5: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join. Fasten off.

Rnd 6: Join white, with sl st in first st, ch 5, (dc, ch 2, dc) in same st as sl st, *skip next 2 sts, (dc, ch 2, dc, ch 2, dc) in next st; repeat from * 6 times, skip last st, join with sl st in third ch of ch-5.

Rnd 7: Ch 1, sc in first ch sp, *[ch 3, (sc, picot) in next st, ch 3], sc in each of next 2 ch sps; repeat from * 5 more times; repeat between [], sc in last ch sp, join. Fasten off.

Repeat on remaining armhole.

Ruffle

Row 1: With neck edge toward you, working in **remaining lps** of row 2, join white with sl st in first st, ch 5, (dc, ch 2, dc) in same st as sl st, *skip next 2 sts, (dc, ch 2, dc, ch 2, dc) in next st; repeat from * across, turn.

Row 2: (Sl st, ch 1, sc) in first ch sp, *[ch 3, (sc, picot) in next st, ch 3], sc in each of next 2 ch sps; repeat from * 16 more times; repeat between [], sc in last st. Fasten off.

Row 3: Working around neck edge in starting ch on opposite side of row 1 on Dress, join white with sc in first ch, sc in each ch across, turn.

Row 4: Ch 1, **reverse sc** (see Stitch Guide) in each st across. Fasten off.

Left Placket

Row 1: Working in ends of rows, join lt. pink with sc in last row, 2 sc in each dc row, sc in each sc row and evenly spaced 3 sc across hdc rows, sl st in first ch at neck, turn. (20 sc made)

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first st; (**for buttonhole**, ch 1, skip next st; sc in next 5 sts) 3 times, sl st in last st, turn.

Row 3: Sl st in each st and in each ch across. Fasten off.

Right Placket

Row 1: Working in ends of rows, join lt. pink with sc in last ch at neck, evenly spaced 3 sc across hdc rows, sc in sc rows, 2 sc in each dc row across, sl st in base of last dc, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each st across, sl st in top of sl st of row 1, turn.

Row 3: Sl st in each st across. Fasten off.

Overskirt

Row 1: With neck edge towards you, working in **remaining lps** on row 10 of Dress, join white with sl st in first st, ch 4, dc in same st as sl st, *skip next st, (dc, ch 1, dc) in each of next 2 sts; repeat from * across to last 2 sts, skip next st, (dc, ch 1, dc) in last st, turn.

Row 2: Ch 3, (dc, ch 2, dc) in each ch sp across, turn.

Rnd 3: Working in rnds, ch 3, (dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc) in each ch-2 sp around, join with sl st in top of first dc.

Rnd 4: Sl st in next ch sp, (sl st, ch 4, dc, ch 1, dc) in next st, (dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc) in center st of each de-group around, join with sl st in third ch of ch-4.

Rnds 5-6: Sl st in next ch sp, (sl st, ch 5, dc, ch 2, dc) in next st, (dc, ch 2, dc, ch 2, dc) in center st of each de-group around, join with sl st in third ch of ch-5.

Rnd 7: Ch 1, sc in first ch sp, *[ch 3, (sc, picot, sc) in next st, ch 3], sc in each of next 2 ch sps; repeat from * 30 more times; repeat between [], sc in last ch sp, join with sc in first st. Fasten off.

Finishing

1: Join white with sc on right side in base of first st of row 1 on Overskirt; working down side in ends of rows 1—3, 2 sc in each row, sl st in joining sl st, 2 sc in each row on other side, sl st in st at base of row 1. Fasten off.

2: Sew buttons to Right Placket opposite buttonholes,

3: Tie 6" piece of 1/8" ribbon in bow around st at center top of each Sleeve.

4: Tie 10" piece 1/4" ribbon in bow around center front st of row 2 on Dress.

BABY'S SHOE (make 2)

Rnd 1: With lt. pink, ch 6, (beg hdc, 2 hdc) in second ch from hook, sc in each of next 3 chs, 5 hdc in end ch; working on opposite side of starting ch, sc in each of next 3 chs, 2 hdc in same ch as beg hdc, join with sl st in top of beg hdc. (16 sts made)

Rnd 2: (Beg hdc, hdc) in first st, hdc in each of next 2 sts, sc in each of next 3 sts, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next st, 3 hdc in next st, hdc in next st, 2 hdc in next st, sc in each of next 3 sts, hdc in each of last 2 sts, hdc in same st as beg hdc, join. (22)

Rnd 3: (Beg hdc, hdc) in first st, hdc in next 8 sts, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next st, 3 hdc

in next st, hdc in next st, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 8 sts, hdc in same st as beg hdc, join. (28)

Rnd 4: Working in **back lps** (see Stitch Guide), ch 1, sc in each st around, join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, sc in first 10 sts, hdc in next 9 sts, sc in last 9 sts, join.

Rnd 6: Ch 1, sc in first 9 sts, (hdc next 2 sts tog, hdc in next st) 3 times, hdc next 2 sts tog, sc in last 8 sts, join. Fasten off. (24]

Rnd 7: Working in **back lps**, join white with sc in first st, sc in next 7 sts, (dc next 2 sts tog) 2 times, dc in next st, (dc next 2 sts tog) 2 times, sc in last 7 sts, join. (20)

Rnds 8-9: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Rnd 10: Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sts, 2 sc in next st, (sc in each of next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st) around, join. (25)

Rnd 11: Working in **back lps**, ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Rnd 12: Ch 1, **sc fp** (see Stitch Guide) around each st around, join.

Rnd 13: Sl st in each st around, join with sl st in first sl st. Fasten off.

Rnd 14: With bottom of Shoe facing away from you, working in **remaining lps** of md 10, join white with sl st in center st at back, ch 1, (sl st, ch 1) in each st around, join. Fasten off.

For **ties**, with lt. pink, ch 30, join with sl st in center st at back, ch 30. Fasten off. Tie ends in bow at front.

BABY'S HAT

Row 1: With white, ch 38, beg hdc in second ch from hook, ch 1, skip next ch, hdc in next ch, (ch 1, skip next ch, hdc in next ch) across, **do not turn**.

Row 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in side of last hdc; working in starting ch on opposite side of row 1, sc in each ch and in each sp across, 2 sc in end of row 1, sc in each st and in each sp across row 1, turn.

Row 3: Working in **front lps**, ch 1, sc in first st, (ch 2, sc in next st) 36 times, sl st in next st leaving remaining sts unworked. Fasten off.

Row 4: Working in **remaining lps** on row 2, join lt. pink with beg dc in first st, dc in same st as beg dc, 2 dc in each of next 37 sts. Fasten off.

For **ties**, weave 30" piece 1/4" ribbon through ch sps on row 1.

BEAR'S DRESS

Row 1: With lt. pink, ch 21, sc in second ch from hook, 2 sc in next ch, (sc in next ch, 2 sc in next ch) across, turn. (30 sc made)

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 3: Working in **back lps**, ch 1, sc in next 14 sts, 2 sc in each of next 2 sts, sc in next 14 sts, turn. (32)

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in first 5 sts; for **armhole**, ch 5, skip next 8 sts; sc in next 6 sts; for **armhole**, ch 5, skip next 8 sts; sc in next 5 sts, turn.

Rnd 5: Working in mds, ch 1, sc in each st and in each ch around, join with sl st in first sc. (26)

Rnd 6: Working in **back lps**, (beg dc, dc) in first st, 2 dc in each st around, join with sl st in top of beg dc.

Rnd 7: Beg dc in first st, dc in each st around, join.

Rnd 8: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join. Fasten off.

Rnd 9: Working in **back lps**, join white with sl st in first st, sl st in each st around, join with sl st in first st. Fasten off.

Rnd 10: Working in **remaining lps** of md 5, join white with sl st in first st, (ch 5, dc, ch 2, dc) in same st as sl st, *skip next 2 sts, (dc, ch 2, dc, ch 2, dc) in next st; repeat from *

around to last st, skip last st, join with sl st in third ch of beg ch-5.

Rnd 11: Ch 1, sc in first ch sp, *[ch 3, (sc, picot, sc) in next st, ch 3], sc in each of next 2 ch sps; repeat from * 7 more times; repeat between [], sc in last ch sp, join. Fasten off.

Row 12: Working in **remaining lps** of row 2, join white with sc in first st, (ch 1, sc) in each st across. Fasten off.

Finishing

1: For **plackets**, working in ends of rows across back opening, join lt. pink with sc in first row, sc in each row across, sl st in joining sl st, sc in each row across, sl st in starting ch. Fasten off.

2: For **ties**, with white, ch 25; working in starting ch on opposite side of row 1 on Dress, sc in each ch across, ch 25. Fasten off.

3: Tie 8" piece of 1/8" ribbon in bow around center st at front of row 2.00

CHRISTMAS DRESS

(Shown on back cover at center.)

FINISHED SIZES:

Baby clothes fit 14" doll. Bear clothes fit a 4" bear.

MATERIALS:

GAUGE:

5 dc = 1"; 1 sc and 2 dc rows = 1".

BASIC STITCHES:

Ch, sl st, sc, hdc, dc.

BABY'S DRESS

Row 1: Starting at bodice, with red, ch 37, hdc in third ch from hook, hdc in each of next 2 chs, (3 hdc in next ch, dc in next 8 chs) 3 times, 3 hdc in next ch, hdc in last 4 chs, turn. (44 hdc made)

Row 2: (Sc, ch 1) in first st (beg hdc made), hdc in next 4 sts, (3 hdc in next st, hdc in next 10 sts) 3 times, 3 hdc in next st, hdc in last 5 sts, turn. (52)

Row 3: Working in **back lps** (see Stitch Guide), beg hdc in first st, hdc in next 5 sts, (3 hdc in next st, hdc in next 12 sts) 3 times, 3 hdc in next st, hdc in last 6 sts, turn.(60)

Row 4: Beg hdc in first st, hdc in next 6 sts, (3 hdc in next st, hdc in next 14 sts) 3 times, 3 hdc in next st, hdc in last 7 sts, turn. (68)

Row 5: Working in **back lps**, beg hdc in first st, hdc in next 7 sts, (2 hdc, dc) in next st, 2 dc in each of next 16 sts, (dc, 2 hdc) in next st, hdc in next 16 sts, (2 hdc, dc) in next st, 2 dc in each of next 16 sts, (dc, 2 hdc) in next st, hdc in last 8 sts, turn. (108 sts)

Row 6: Beg hdc in first st, hdc in next 9 sts; for **armhole**, ch 4, skip next 34 sts; hdc in next 20 sts: for **armhole**, ch 4, skip next 34 sts; hdc in last 10 sts, turn.

Row 7: Beg hdc in first st, hdc in each st and in each ch across, turn. (48 hdc)

Row 8: Beg hdc in first st, hdc in each st across, turn.

Rows 9-10; Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 11: Working in **front lps**, for **skirt**, (sc, ch 2) in first st [beg dc made), dc in same st as beg dc, 2 dc in each st across, turn. (96)

Row 12: Beg dc in first st, dc in each st across, turn.

Rnd 13: Working in rnds, (beg dc, dc) in first st, dc in next st, (2 dc in next st, dc in next st) around, join with sl st in top of beg dc. (144)

Rnds 14-19: Beg dc in first st, dc in each st around, join.

Rnd 20: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 21: Working in **back lps**, beg dc in first st, dc in each st around, join.

Rnds 22-23: Beg dc in first st, dc in each st around, join.

Rnd 24: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Rnd 25: Ch 1, **reverse sc** (see Stitch Guide) in each st around, join. Fasten off.

Rnd 26: For **skirt ruffle**, working in **remaining lps** of rnd 20, join pompadour with beg dc in first st, (ch 2, dc, ch 2, dc) in same st as beg dc, skip next st, dc in next st, skip next st, *(dc, ch 2, dc, ch 2, dc) in next st, skip next st, dc in next st, skip next st; repeat from * around, join.

Rnd 27: Ch 1, sc in first ch sp, *[ch 3, (sc; for **picot**, **ch 3**, **sl st in top of last st made**) in next st, ch 3], sc in each of next 2 ch sps; repeat from * 34 more times; repeat between [], sc in last ch sp, join. Fasten off.

Rnd 28: For **first bodice ruffle**, working in **remaining lps** of row 4, join pompadour with sl st in first st, (sl st, ch 5, dc, ch 2, dc) in next st, *skip next 2 sts, (dc, ch 2, dc, ch 2, dc) in next st; repeat from * across, turn.

Rnd 29: Ch 1, sc in first ch sp, *[ch 3, (sc, picot) in next st, ch 3], sc in each of next 2 ch sps; repeat from * 21 more times; repeat between []. sc in last ch sp. Fasten off.

Rnd 30: For **second bodice ruffle**, working in **remaining lps** of row 2, join pompadour with sl st in first st, (ch 5, dc, ch 2, dc) in same st as sl st, *skip next 2 sts, (dc, ch 2, dc, ch 2, dc) in next st; repeat from * across, turn.

Rnd 31: Ch 1, sc in first ch sp, *[ch 3, (sc, picot) in next st, ch 3], sc in each of next 2 ch sps; repeat from * 16 more times; repeat between [], sc in last ch sp. Fasten off.

Underskirt

Row 1: Working in **remaining lps** of row 10, join white baby yarn with beg dc in first st, dc in same st as beg dc, 2 dc in each st across, turn. (96 dc made)

Row 2: Beg dc in first st, dc in each st across, turn.

Rnd 3: Working in mds, (beg dc, dc) in first st, dc in next st, (2 dc in next st, dc in next st) around, join with sl st in top of beg dc. (144)

Rnds 4—12: Beg dc in first st, dc in each st around, join.

Rnd 13: Ch 1, sc in first st, ch 1, (sc, ch 1) in each st around, join. Fasten off.

Rnd 14: Join pompadour yarn with beg dc in first ch sp, (ch 2, dc, ch 2, dc) in same sp as beg dc, dc in next ch sp, *(dc, ch 2, dc, ch 2, dc) in next ch sp, dc in next ch sp; repeat from "around, join.

Rnd 15: Ch 1, sc in first ch sp, *[ch 3, (sc, picot) in next st, ch 3], sc in each of next 2 ch sps; repeat from * 35 more times; repeat between [], sc in last ch sp, join. Fasten off.

Weave 36" piece of 1/8" ribbon through ch sps on rnd 13, tack ends together in back.

Sleeve

Rnd 1: Working in chs, in ends of rows and in sts on armhole, skip first 2 chs, join red with sc in next ch, sc in next ch, hdc in end of row 6, dc next 2 sts tog, dc in next 30 sts, dc next 2 sts tog, hdc in end of row 6, sc in each of last 2 chs, join with sl st in first sc. (38 sts made)

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sts, dc next 2 sts tog, dc in next 28 sts, dc next 2 sts tog, sc in each of last 3 sts, join. (36)

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sts, dc next 2 sts tog, dc in next 26 sts, dc next 2 sts tog, sc in each of last 3 sts, join. (34)

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sts, dc in each st across to last 3 sts, sc in each of last 3 sts, join.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sts, (dc next 2 sts tog) 14 times, sc in each of last 3 sts, join.

Rnd 6: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join. Fasten off.

Rnd 7: Join pompadour with sc in first st, sc in each st around, join.

Rnd 8: (Ch 5, dc, ch 2, dc) in first st, *skip next 2 sts, (dc, ch 2, dc, ch 2, dc) in next st; repeat from * 5 more times, skip last sc, join with sl st in. third ch of ch-5.

Rnd 9: Ch 1, sc in first ch sp, *[ch 3, (sc, picot) in next st, ch 3], sc in each of next 2 ch sps; repeat from * 5 more times; repeat between [], sc in last ch sp. Fasten off.

Repeat on other armhole.

Tie 6" piece of 1/8" ribbon in bow around center dc at top of each Sleeve.

Collar

Row 1: Working in starting ch on opposite side of row 1 on Dress, join pompadour with sc in first ch, (ch 2, skip next ch, sc in next ch) across to last ch, sc in last ch, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, (sc, picot) in each ch sp across. Fasten off.

Cut two pieces of 1/4" ribbon each 9" long. Beginning at back on each side, weave each piece through ch sps on row 1 to center front. Fold and tack ends in back to secure, tie ends in bow at front.

Left Placket

Row 1: With right side facing you, join red with sc in base of dc at bottom of left back opening on Dress; working in ends of rows, evenly space 18 more sc across, sl st in first ch on row 1, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, skip sl st, sc in first sc; (for **buttonhole**, ch 1, skip next st, sc in next 5 sts) 3 times, turn.

Row 3: Sl st in each st and in each ch across, sl st in ch-1 on last row. Fasten off.

Right Placket

Row 1: With right side facing you, join red with sc in last ch at neck; working in ends of rows, evenly space 18 more sc across, sl st in base of last dc, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, skip sl st, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 3: Sl st in each st across, sl st in ch-1 on last row. Fasten off.

Sew buttons to Right Placket opposite buttonholes.

Tie 1 yd. of 1/4" ribbon around waist with bow in back.

BABY'S RUFFLED PANTIES

Row 1: With pompadour, ch 25, sc in second ch from hook, sc in each ch across, turn. (24 sc made)

Rows 2-4: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Rows 5-9: Ch 1, skip first st, sc in each st across to last st, skip last st, turn. At end of row 9 [14].

Row 10: Skip first st, sl st in next st, sc in next 10 sts, sl st in next st, leaving remaining st unworked, turn. (10 sc)

Row 11: Ch 1, skip sl st, skip next st, sl st in next st, sc in next 6 sts, sl st in next st, leave last st unworked, turn. (6 sc)

Row 12: Ch 1 sc in each st across, turn.

Row 13: Skip first st, sc in each of next 3 sts, skip next st, sc in last st, turn. (4 sc)

Rows 14-16: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 17: Ch 1, 2 sc in first st, sc in each st across with 2 sc in last st, turn.(6)

Row 18: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Rows 19-24: Repeat rows 17 and 18 alternately. At end of row 24 (12).

Row 25: Ch 1, 2 sc in each st across, turn.(24)

Rows 26-29: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 30: Working in **front lps**, ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Rows 31-32: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 33: Working in **back lps**, ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Rows 34-35: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn. At end of last row, fasten off.

Sew ends of rows 1—5 to ends of rows 31—35 for side seams.

For **waist**, working in starting ch and in sts of row 35, join pompadour with sc in any st, sc in each st and in each ch around, join. Fasten off.

Leg Trim

Rnd 1: Working in ends of rows 6—30, join pompadour with sc in any row, *sc in each row around, join.

Rnd 2: (Ch 2, sl st) in each st around, ch 2, join with sl st in last joining sl st. Fasten off.

Ruffles

Row 1; Working in **remaining lps** of row 29, join pompadour with beg dc in first st, (ch 2, dc, ch 2, dc) in same st as beg dc, skip next st, dc in next st, skip next st, (dc, ch 2, dc, ch 2, dc) in next st, skip next st, dc in next st, skip next st, (dc, ch 2, dc, ch 2, dc) in next st, dc in next st, (dc, ch 2, dc, ch 2, dc) in next st, dc in next st, *skip next st, (dc, ch 2, dc, ch 2, dc) in next st, skip next st, dc in next st; repeat from * once more, skip next st, (dc, ch 2, dc, ch 2, dc) in next st, dc in next st, sl st in last st, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first ch sp, *[ch 3, (sc, picot) in next st, ch 3], sc in each of next 2 ch sps; repeat from * 5 more times; repeat between [], sc in last ch sp. Fasten off.

Repeat rows 1 and 2 in remaining lps of row 32.

Tie 8" piece of white ribbon in bow around one sc on each side at seams.

BABY'S SHOE (make 2)

Rnd 1: With red, ch 6, (beg hdc, 2 hdc) in second ch from hook, sc in each of next 3 chs, 5 hdc in end ch; working on opposite side of starting ch, sc in each of next 3 chs, 2 hdc in same ch as beg hdc, join with sl st in top of beg hdc. (16 sts made)

Rnd 2: (Beg hdc, hdc) in first st, hdc in each of next 2 sts, sc in each of next 3 sts, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next st, 3 hdc in next st, hdc in next st, 2 hdc in next st, sc in each of next 3 sts, hdc in each of last 2 sts, hdc in same st as beg hdc, join. (22)

Rnd 3: (Beg hdc, hdc) in first st, hdc in next 8 sts, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next st, 3 hdc in next st, hdc in next st, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 8 sts, hdc in same st as beg hdc, join.(28)

Rnd 4: Working in **back lps** (see Stitch Guide), ch 1, sc in each st around, join with sl st

in first sc.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, sc in first 10 sts, hdc in next 9 sts, sc in last 9 sts, join.

Rnd 6: Ch 1, sc in first 9 sts, (hdc next 2 sts tog, hdc in next st) 3 times, hdc next 2 sts tog, sc in last 8 sts, join. Fasten off. (24)

Rnd 7: Working in **back lps**, join white with sc in first st, sc in next 7 sts, (dc next 2 sts tog) 2 times, dc in next st, (dc next 2 sts tog) 2 times, sc in last 7 sts, join. (20)

Rnd 8: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Rnd 9: Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sts, 2 sc in next st, (sc in each of next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st) around, join. (25)

Rnd 10: Working in **back lps**, ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Rnds 11-12: Ch 1, sc fp (see Stitch Guide) around each st around, join.

Rnd 13: Sl st in each st around, join with sl st in first st. Fasten off.

Rnd 14: Working in **remaining lps** of rnd 9, join white with sl st in center back st, (ch 2, sl st in next st) around, join. Fasten off.

Tie 6" piece of 1/8" ribbon in bow around center st of rnd 6 on toe.

BABY'S HAIRBAND

Rnd 1: With red, ch 55 loosely, sl st in first ch to form ring, ch 1, sc in each ch around, join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc fp around each st around, join. Fasten off.

Rnd 3: Join white with sc in first st, sc in next 12 sts, (ch 2, sc in next st) 30 times, sc in last 12 sts, join.

Fasten off. Tie 6" piece of 1/8" ribbon in bow around any st on rnd 2 for front.

BEAR'S DRESS

Row 1: With red, ch 21, sc in second ch from hook, 2 sc in next ch, (sc in next ch, 2 sc in next ch) across, turn. (30 sc made)

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 3: Working in **back lps**, ch 1, sc in next 14 sts, 2 sc in each of next 2 sts, sc in next 14 sts, turn. (32)

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in first 5 sts; for **armhole**, ch 5, skip next 8 sts; sc in next 6 sts; for **armhole**, ch 5, skip next 8 sts; sc in next 5 sts, turn.

Rnd 5: Working in rnds, ch 1, sc in each st and in each ch around, join with sl st in first sc. (26)

Rnd 6: Working in **front lps**, (beg dc, dc) in first st, 2 dc in each st around, join with sl st in top of beg dc.

Rnd 7: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Rnd 8: Working in **back lps**, beg dc in first st, dc in each st around, join. Fasten off.

Rnd 9: For **skirt ruffle**, working in **remaining lps** of rnd 7, join pompadour with sc in first st, ch 2, (sc, ch 2) in each st around, join. Fasten off.

Row 10: For **bodice ruffle**, working in **remaining lps** of row 2, join pompadour with sc in first st, (ch 2, sc) in each st across. Fasten off.

Underskirt

Rnd 1: Working in **remaining lps** of rnd 5, join white with beg dc in first st, dc in same st as beg dc, 2 dc in each st around, join with sl st in beg dc.

Rnd 2: Beg dc in first st, dc in each st around, join.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in first st, ch 1, skip next st, (sc in next st, ch 1, skip next st) around, join. Fasten off.

Rnd 4: Join pompadour with sc in first ch sp, (ch 2, sc) in same ch sp as first sc, (sc, ch 2, sc) in each ch sp around, join. Fasten off.

BEAR'S PANTIES

Rnd 1: With pompadour, ch 27, sl st in first ch to form ring, sc in each ch around, join with sl st in first sc. (27 sc made)

Rnd 2: (Beg dc, 2 dc) in first st, hdc in next st, sc in next 10 sts, hdc in next st, 5 dc in next st, hdc in next st, sc in next 10 sts, hdc in next st, 2 dc in last st, join with sl st in top of beg dc. (34 sts)

Rnd 3: Ch 1, 2 sc in first st, sc in next 16 sts, 3 sc in next st, sc in next 15 sts, 2 sc in last st, join. (38 sc)

Rnd 4: Ch 1, 2 sc in first st, sc in next 18 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in last 18 sts, join. (40)

Rnd 5: For **first leg**, fold piece, matching first 2 sts and center 2 sts, working through all thicknesses for 2 sts only, ch 1, sc in first st, sc in next st after center st, sc in next 17 sts, join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 6: For **second leg**, working through both thicknesses for 2 sts only, sc in next st and next center st, sc in each st around, join. Fasten off.

Rnd 7: For **waistband**, working in starting ch on opposite side of row 1, join with sc in first ch, sc in each ch around, join. Fasten off.

Finishing

1: Working in ends of rows across back opening of Dress, join red with sc in end of row 1, sc in each row across, sl st in joining sl st, sc in each row across, sl st in starting ch. Fasten off.

2: For **tie**, with pompadour, ch 25; working in starting ch on opposite side of row 1 on Dress, sc in each ch across, ch 25. Fasten off.

3: Weave 12" piece 1/8" ribbon through ch sps on rnd 3 of Underskirt. Tack ends together in back to secure.

4: Tie 6" piece 1/8" ribbon in bow around center st at front on row 2 of Dress.

CHRISTENING DRESS

(Shown on back cover at left.)

FINISHED SIZES:

Baby clothes fit 14" doll. Bear clothes fit a 4" bear.

BASIC STITCHES:

Ch, sl st, sc, hdc, dc.

SPECIAL STITCHES:

For **shell**, (dc, ch 2, dc, ch 2, dc) in next st or ch sp.

For **picot**, ch 3, sl st in top of st just made.

BABY'S DRESS

Row 1: Starting at bodice, ch 37, hdc in third ch from hook, hdc in each of next 2 chs, (3 hdc in next ch, dc in next 8 chs) 3 times, 3 hdc in next ch, hdc in last 4 chs, turn (44 hdc made)

Row 2: (Sc, ch 1) in first st (beg hdc made), hdc in next 4 sts, (3 hdc in next st, hdc in next 10 sts) 3 times, 3 hdc in next st, hdc in last 5 sts, turn. (52)

Row 3: Beg hdc in first st, hdc in next 5 sts, (3 hdc in next st, hdc in next 12 sts) 3 times, 3 hdc in next st, hdc in last 6 sts, turn. (60)

Row 4: Beg hdc in first st, hdc in next 6 sts, (3 hdc in next st, hdc in next 14 sts) 3 times, 3 hdc in next st, hdc in last 7 sts, turn. (68)

Row 5: Working in **back lps** (see Stitch Guide), beg hdc in first st, hdc in next 7 sts, (2 hdc, dc) in next st, 2 dc in each of next 16 sts, (dc, 2 hdc) in next st, hdc in next 16 sts, (2 hdc, dc) in next st, 2 dc in each of next 16 sts, (dc, 2 hdc) in next st, hdc in last 8 sts, turn. (108 sts)

Row 6: Beg hdc in first st, hdc in next 9 sts; for **armhole**, ch 4, skip next 34 sts; hdc in next 20 sts: for **armhole**, ch 4, skip next 34 sts; hdc in last 10 sts, turn.

Row 7: Beg hdc in first st, hdc in each st and in each ch across, turn. (48 hdc)

Row 8: Beg hdc in first st, hdc in each st across, turn.

Rows 9-10: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 11: Working in **back lps**, (sc, ch 2) in first st (beg dc made), 1 dc in next st, (dc in next st, 2 dc in next st) across, turn. (72)

Row 12: Beg dc in first st, dc in each st across, turn.

Rnds 13-17: Working in mds, beg dc in first st, dc in each st around, join with sl st in top of beg dc.

Rnd 18: Ch 1, sc in each of first 2 sts, 2 sc in next st, (sc in each of next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st) around, join with sl st in first sc. (96)

Rnd 19: Working in **back lps**, beg dc in first st, dc in each st around, join.

Rnds 20-24: Beg dc in first st, dc in each st around, join.

Rnd 25: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Rnd 26: For **bottom ruffle**, (ch 4, dc) in first st, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next st, skip next st, *(dc, ch 1, dc) in each of next 2 sts, skip next st; repeat from * around, join with sl st in third ch of ch-4.

Rnd 27: (Sl st, ch 5, dc) in first ch sp, (dc, ch 2, dc) in each ch sp around, join with sl st in third ch of ch-5.

Rnd 28: (Sl st, ch 4, dc, ch 1, dc) in first ch sp, (dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc) in each ch sp around, join with sl st in third ch of ch-4.

Rnd 29: Sl st in next ch sp, (sl st, ch

4. dc, ch 1, dc) in next st (center st of group), (dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc) in center st of each group around, join.

Rnd 30: Sl st in next ch sp, (sl st, ch

5. dc, ch 2, dc) in next center st, shell (see Special Stitches) in center st of each group or shell around, join with sl st in third ch of ch-5.

Rnds 31-33: Sl st in next ch sp, (sl st, ch 5, dc, ch 2, dc) in next center st, shell in center st of each group or shell around, join with sl st in third ch of ch-5.

Rnd 34: Ch 1, sc in next ch sp, *[ch 3, (sc, **picot**—see Special Stitches) in center st, ch 3], sc in each of next 2 ch sps; repeat from * around to last shell; repeat between [], sc in last ch sp, join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

Rnd 35: For **center ruffle**, holding Dress with bottom ruffle away from you; working in **remaining lps** on md 18, join with sl st in first st, (ch 4, dc) in same st as sl st, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next st, skip next st, *(dc, ch 1, dc) in each of next 2 sts, skip next st; repeat from * around, join with sl st in third ch of ch-4.

Rnds 36-43: Repeat mds 27-34.

Row 44: For **top ruffle**, holding Dress with bottom ruffle away from you, working in **remaining lps** on row 10, join with sl st in first st, (ch 4, dc) in same st as sl st, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next st, *skip next st, (dc, ch 1, dc) in each of next 2 sts; repeat from * across, turn.

Row 45: (Sl st, ch 5, dc) in first ch sp, (dc, ch 2, dc) in each ch sp across, turn.

Rnd 46: Working in mds, ch 4, (dc, dc, ch 1, dc) in first ch sp, (dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc) in each ch sp around, join with sl st in third ch of ch-4.

Rnds 47-52: Repeat mds 29-34.

Row 53: For **top ruffle placket**, working in ends of rows, join with sc in base of dc on row 44, 2 sc in each dc row, sl st in joining sl st, 2 sc in each dc row, sl st in st at base of row 44. Fasten off.

Row 54: For **bodice ruffle**, working in **remaining lps** of row 4, with neck edge towards you, join with sl st in first st, (ch 5, dc, ch 2, dc) in same st as sl st, (skip next 2 sts, shell in next st) across, turn.

Row 55: Ch 1, sc in first ch sp, *[ch 3, (sc, picot) in next st, ch 3], sc in each of next 2 ch sps; repeat from * across to last shell; repeat between [], sc in last ch sp. Fasten off.

Sleeve

Rnd 1: Working in chs and sts on annhole, skip first 2 chs, join with sc in next ch, sc in next ch, hdc in end of row 6, dc next 2 sts tog, dc in next 30 sts, dc next 2 sts tog, hdc in end of row 6, sc in each of last 2 chs, join with sl st in first sc. (38 sts made)

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sts, dc next 2 sts tog, dc in next 28 sts, dc next 2 sts tog, sc in each of last 3 sts, join. (36)

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sts, dc next 2 sts tog, dc in next 26 sts, dc next 2 sts tog, sc in each of last 3 sts, join. (34)

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sts, (dc next 2 sts tog) 14 times, sc in each of last 3 sts, join. (20)

Rnd 5: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Rnd 6: (Ch 5, dc, ch 2, dc) in first st, (skip next 2 sts, shell in next st) 6 times, skip last st, join with sl st in third ch of ch-5.

Rnd 7: Sc in first ch sp, *[ch 3, (sc, picot) in center st of shell, ch 3], sc in each of next 2 ch sps; repeat from * around to last shell; repeat between [], sc in last ch sp, join. Fasten off.

Repeat on other armhole.

Tie 6" piece of 1/8" ribbon in bow around st at center top of each Sleeve.

Collar

Row 1: Working in starting ch on opposite side of row 1 on Dress, join with sc in first ch, (ch 2, skip next ch, sc in next ch) across, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, (sc, picot) in each ch sp across, sl st in last st. Fasten off.

Cut two 10" pieces of 1/4" ribbon. Starting in back on sides, weave ribbons through ch sps on row 1 to front. Tack ends in back to secure. Tie ends in front in bow.

Left Placket

Row 1: With right side facing you, join with sc in base of dc at bottom of left back opening; working in ends of rows, evenly space 18 more sc across, sl st in first ch on

row 1, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, skip sl st, sc in first sc; (for **buttonhole**, ch 1, skip next st, sc in next 5 sts) 3 times, turn.

Row 3: Sl st in each st and in each ch across, sl st in ch-1. Fasten off.

Right Placket

Row 1: With right side facing you, join with sc in last ch at neck; working in ends of rows, evenly space 18 more sc across, sl st in base of last dc, turn. **Row 2:** Ch 1, skip sl st, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 3: Sl st in each st across, sl st in ch-1. Fasten off. Sew buttons to Right Placket opposite buttonholes.

Tie 3/8" ribbon around waist in bow at back.

BABY'S SHOE (make 2)

Rnd 1: Ch 6, (beg hdc, 2 hdc) in second ch from hook, sc in each of next 3 chs, 5 hdc in end ch; working on opposite side of starting ch, sc in each of next 3 chs, 2 hdc in same ch as beg hdc, join with sl st in top of beg hdc. (16 sts made)

Rnd 2: (Beg hdc, hdc) in first st, hdc in each of next 2 sts, sc in each of next 3 sts, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next st, 3 hdc in next st, hdc in next st, 2 hdc in next st, sc in each of next 3 sts, hdc in each of last 2 sts, hdc in same st as beg hdc, join. (22)

Rnd 3: (Beg hdc, hdc) in first st, hdc in next 8 sts, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next st, 3 hdc in next st, hdc in next st, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 8 sts, hdc in same st as beg hdc, join. (28)

Rnd 4: Working in **back lps**, ch 1, sc in each st around, join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, sc in first 9 sts, hdc in next 11 sts, sc in last 8 sts, join.

Rnd 6: Ch 1, sc in first 8 sts, (hdc next 2 sts tog, hdc in next st, hdc next 2 sts tog), hdc in each of next 3 sts; repeat between (), sc in last 7 sts, join. (24)

Rnd 7: Ch 1, sc in first 7 sts, (dc next 2 sts tog, dc in next st) 3 times, dc next 2 sts tog, sc in last 6 sts, join. (20)

Rnd 8: Ch 1, sc in first st, ch 1, skip next st, (sc in next st, ch 1, skip next st) around, join.

Rnd 9: (Beg dc, ch 2, dc, ch 2, dc) in first ch sp, skip next ch sp, shell in each of next 2 ch sps, skip next ch sp, shell in next ch sp, skip next ch sp, shell in each of next 2 ch sps, skip last ch sp, join with sl st in top of beg dc.

Rnd 10: Ch 1, sc in first ch sp, *[ch 3, (sc, picot) in next st, ch 3], sc in each of next 2 ch sps; repeat from * around to last shell; repeat between [], sc in last ch sp, join. Fasten off.

Starting in center back, weave 12" piece of 1/4" ribbon through ch sps on rnd 8. Tie ends in bow at front.

BABY'S HAT

Row 1: Ch 38, (beg hdc, ch 1) in second ch from hook, skip next ch, hdc in next ch, (ch 1, skip next ch, hdc in next ch) across, **do not turn**.

Row 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in side of last st made; working in starting ch on opposite side of row 1, sc in each ch across, 2 sc in side of first st on row 1, sc in each st and in each ch sp across row 1, turn.

Rnd 3: Working in **back lps**, ch 1, sc in first st, *shell in next st, (skip next st, dc in next st, skip next st, shell in next st) 3 times, skip next st, dc in next st, shell in next st, skip next st, dc in next st, skip next st, shell in next st, (dc in next st, skip next st, shell in next st, skip next st) 3 times, dc in next st, skip next st, shell in next st, sc in last st, ch 2*, skip next 2 sts, sc in next st; repeat between first and second *, join with sl st in first st.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in first ch sp, *[ch 3, (sc, picot) in next st, ch 3, sc in each of next 2 ch sps; repeat across to last shell before end], sl st in next st, sl st in each of next 2 chs, sl st in next st; repeat between [], sl st in next st, sl st in each of next 2 chs, join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

Row 5: For **front ruffle**, working in 37 sts at front, join with sc in first st, (ch 2, sc) in each of next 36 sts, sl st in next st. Fasten off.

BEAR'S DBESS

Row 1: Ch 21, sc in second ch from hook, 2 sc in next ch, (sc in next ch, 2 sc in next ch) across, turn. (30 sc made)

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 3: Working in **back lps**, ch 1, sc in next 14 sts, 2 sc in each of next 2 sts, sc in next 14 sts, turn. (32)

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in first 5 sts; for **armhole**, ch 5, skip next 8 sts; sc in next 6 sts; for **armhole**, ch 5, skip next 8 sts; sc in next 5 sts, turn.

Rnd 5: Working in rnds, ch 1, sc in each st and in each ch around, join with sl st in first sc. (26)

Rnd 6: Working in **front lps**, (beg dc, dc) in first st, 2 dc in each st around, join with sl st in top of beg dc.

Rnd 7: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Rnd 8: Working in **back lps**, beg dc in first st, dc in each st around, join.

Rnd 9: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Rnd 10: (Ch 5, dc, ch 2, dc) in first st, (skip next 2 sts, shell in next st) around to last st, skip last st, join with sl st in third ch of ch-5.

Rnd 11: Ch 1, sc in first ch sp, *[ch 3, (sc, picot) in next st, ch 3], sc in each of next 2 ch sps; repeat from * around to last shell; repeat between [], sc in last ch sp, join. Fasten off.

Rnd 12: For **center ruffle**, working in **remaining lps** of rnd 7, join with sl st in first st, (ch 5, dc, ch 2, dc) in same st as sl st, skip next st, (shell in next st, skip next 2 sts) around, join with sl st in third ch of ch-5.

Rnd 13: Ch 1, sc in first ch sp, *[ch 3, (sc, picot) in next st, ch 3], sc in each of next 2 ch sps; repeat from * around to last shell; repeat between [], sc in last ch sp, join. Fasten off.

Rnd 14: For **top ruffle**, working in **remaining lps** on rnd 5, join with sl st in first st, (ch 5, dc, ch 2, dc) in same st as sl st, skip next st, (shell in next st, skip next 2 sts) around, join with sl st in third ch of ch-5.

Rnd 15: Ch 1, sc in first ch sp, *[ch 3, (sc, picot) in next st, ch 3], sc in each of next 2 ch sps; repeat from * around to last shell; repeat between [], sc in last ch sp, join. Fasten off.

Row 16: For **bodice ruffle**, working in **remaining lps** of row 2, join with sc in first st, (ch 1, sc) in each st across. Fasten off.

Finishing

1: For **back placket**, working in ends of rows across back opening, join with sc in first row, sc in each row across, sl st in joining sl st, sc in each row across, sl st in starting ch. Fasten off.

2: For **ties**, ch 25; working in starting ch on opposite side of row 1, sc in each ch across, ch 25. Fasten off.

3: Tie 6" piece of 1/8" ribbon in bow around front center st on row 2.

GAUGE:

5 dc = 1"; 1 sc and 2 dc rows = 1".

BASIC STITCHES:

Ch, sl st, sc, hdc, dc.

SPECIAL STITCHES:

For **shell**, (dc, ch 2, dc, ch 2, dc) in next st or ch sp.

For **picot**, ch 3, sl st in top of st inst made.

BABY'S DRESS

Row 1: Starting at bodice, with yellow, ch 37, hdc in third ch from hook, hdc in each of next 2 chs, (3 hdc in next ch, dc in next 8 chs) 3 times, 3 hdc in next ch, hdc in last 4 chs, turn. (44 hdc made)

Row 2: (Sc, ch 1) in first st (beg hdc made), hdc in next 4 sts, (3 hdc in next st, hdc in next 10 sts) 3 times, 3 hdc in next st, hdc in last 5 sts, turn.(52)

Row 3: Beg hdc in first st, hdc in next 5 sts, (3 hdc in next st, hdc in next 12 sts) 3 times, 3 hdc in next st, hdc in last 6 sts, turn. (60)

Row 4: Beg hdc in first st, hdc in next 6 sts, (3 hdc in next st, hdc in next 14 sts) 3 times, 3 hdc in next st, hdc in last 7 sts, turn. (68)

Row 5: Working in **back lps** (see Stitch Guide), beg hdc in first st, hdc in next 7 sts, (2 hdc, dc) in next st, 2 dc in each of next 16 sts, (dc, 2 hdc) in next st, hdc in next 16 sts, (2 hdc, dc) in next st, 2 dc in each of next 16 sts, (dc, 2 hdc) in next st, hdc in last 8 sts, trrn. (108 sts)

Row 6: Beg hdc in first st, hdc in next 9 sts; for **armhole**, ch 4, skip next 34 sts; hdc in next 20 sts; for **armhole**, ch 4, skip next 34 sts; hdc in last 10 sts, turn.

Row 7: Beg hdc in first st, hdc in each st and in each ch across, turn. (48 hdc)

Row 8: Beg hdc in first st, hdc in each st across, turn.

Rows 9-10: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 11: Working in **back lps**, for **underskirt**, (sc, ch 2) in first st (beg dc made), 2 dc in next st, (dc in next st, 2 dc in each st) across, turn. (72 dc)

Row 12: Beg dc in first st, dc in each st across, turn.

Rnds 13-17: Working in mds, beg dc in first st, dc in each st around, join with sl st in top of beg dc.

Rnd 18: Ch 1, sc in each of first 2 sts, 2 sc in next st, (sc in each of next 2 sts, 2 sc in

next st) around, join with sl st in first sc. (96)

Rnd 19: Working in **back lps**, beg dc in first st, dc in each st around, join.

Rnds 20-25: Beg dc in first st, dc in each st around, join.

Rnd 28: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join. Fasten off.

Rnd 27: For **bottom ruffle**, join white with sl st in first st, (ch 5, dc, ch 2, dc) in same st as sl st, skip next 3 sts, (**shell**—see Special Stitches— in next st, skip next 3 sts) around, join with sl st in third ch of ch-5.

Rnd 28: Ch 1, sc in first ch sp, *[ch 3, (sc, **picot**—see Special Stitches) in next st, ch 3], sc in each of next 2 ch sps; repeat from * around to last shell; repeat between [], sc in last ch sp, join. Fasten off.

Rnd 29: For **center ruffle**, with bottom ruffle facing away from you, working in **remaining lps** of rnd 18, join white with sl st in first st, (ch 4, dc) in same st as sl st, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next st, skip next st, *(dc, ch 1, dc) in each of next 2 sts, skip next st; repeat from * around, join with sl st in third ch of ch-4.

Rnd 30: (Sl st, ch 5, dc) in first ch sp, (dc, ch 2, dc) in each ch sp around, join with sl st in third ch of ch-5.

Rnd 31: (Sl st, ch 4, dc, ch 1, dc) in first ch sp, (dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc) in each ch sp around, join.

Rnd 32: Sl st in next ch sp, (sl st, ch 4, dc, ch 1, dc) in next st, (dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc) in center st of each group around, join.

Rnd 33: Sl st in next ch sp, (sl st, ch 5, dc, ch 2, dc) in next st, shell in center st of each group or shell around, join.

Rnds 34-36: Sl st in next ch sp, (sl st, ch 5, dc, ch 2, dc) in next st, shell in center st of each group around, join.

Rnd 37: Ch 1, sc in first ch sp, *[ch 3, (sc, picot) in next st, ch 3], sc in each of next 2 ch sps; repeat from * around to last shell; repeat between [], sc in last ch sp, join. Fasten off.

Row 38: For **top ruffle**, with bottom ruffle facing away from you, working in **remaining lps** of row 10, skip first st, join white with sl st in next st, (ch 4, dc) in same st as sl st, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next st, *skip next st, (dc, ch 1, dc) in each of next 2 sts; repeat from * across, turn.

Row 39: Ch 3, (dc, ch 2, dc) in each ch sp across, turn.

Rnd 40: Working in rnds, ch 3, (dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc) in each ch sp around, join with sl st in first dc.

Rnds 41-46: Repeat rnds 32-37.

Row 47: For **top ruffle placket**, working in ends of rows on top ruffle, join white with sc in first row, 2 sc in each row across, sl st in joining sl st, 2 sc in each row across, sl st in next sc at base of first row. Fasten off.

Row 48: For **bodice ruffle**, with neck edge towards you, working in **remaining lps** on row 4, skip first st, join white with sl st in next st, (ch 5, dc, ch 2, dc) in same st as sl st, (skip next 2 sts, shell in next st) across, turn.

Row 49: Ch 1, sc in first ch sp, *[ch 3, (sc, picot) in next st, ch 3], sc in each of next 2 ch sps; repeat from * across to last shell; repeat between [], sc in last ch sp. Fasten off.

Row 50: For **collar**, working in starting ch on opposite side of row 1, join white with sl st in first ch, sl st in each ch across. Fasten off.

Sleeve

Rnd 1: Working in chs, in ends of rows and in sts on armhole, skip first 2 chs, join yellow with sc in next ch, sc in next ch, hdc in end of row 6, dc next 2 sts tog, dc in next 30 sts, dc next 2 sts tog, hdc in end of row 6, sc in each of last 2 chs, join with sl st in first sc. (38 sts made)

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sts, dc next 2 sts tog, dc in next 28 sts, dc next 2 sts tog, sc in each of last 3 sts, join. (36)

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sts, dc next 2 sts tog, dc in next 26 sts, dc next 2 sts tog, sc in each of last 3 sts, join. (34)

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sts, (dc next 2 sts tog) 14 times, sc in each of last 3 sts, join. (20)

Rnd 5: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join. Fasten off.

Rnd 6: Join white with sl st in first st, (ch 5, dc, ch 2, dc) in same st as sl st, (skip next 2 sts, shell in next st) 6 times, skip last st, join with sl st in third ch of ch-5.

Rnd 7: Ch 1, sc in first ch sp, *[ch 3, (sc, picot) in next st, ch 3, sc in each of next 2 ch sps; repeat from * around to last shell; repeat between [], sc in last ch sp, join. Fasten off.

Repeat on other armhole. Tie 6" piece of W ribbon in bow around center st at top of row 5 on each Sleeve.

Left Placket

Row 1: With right side facing you, join yellow with sc in base of dc at bottom of left back opening; working in ends of rows, evenly space 18 more sc across, sl st in first ch on row 1, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, skip sl st, sc in first sc; (for **buttonhole**, ch 1, skip next st, sc in next 5 sts) 3 times, turn.

Row 3: Sl st in each st and in each ch across, sl st in ch-1. Fasten off.

Right Placket

Row 1: With right side facing you, join yellow with sc in last ch at neck; working in ends of rows, evenly space 18 more sc across, sl st in base of last dc, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, skip sl st, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 3: Sl st in each st across, sl st in ch-1. Fasten off.

Sew buttons to Right Placket opposite buttonholes.

Sew decorative button to center front on row 2.

Tie 18" piece of 3/8" ribbon in bow around center st in front on row 10.

BABY'S PANTIES

Row 1: With white, ch 25, sc in second ch from hook, sc in each ch across, turn. (24 sc made)

Rows 2-4: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Rows 5-9: Ch 1, skip first st, sc in each st across to last st, skip last st, turn. At end of row 9 (14).

Row 10: Skip first st, sl st in next st, sc in next 10 sts, sl st in next st leaving remaining st unworked, turn. (10 sc)

Row 11: Ch 1, skip sl st, skip next st, sl st in next st, sc in next 6 sts, sl st in next st leaving last st unworked, turn. (6 sc)

Row 12: Ch 1 sc in each st across, turn.

Row 13: Skip first st, sc in each of next 3 sts, skip next st, sc in last st, turn. (4 sc)

Rows 14-16; Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 17: Ch 1, 2 sc in first st, sc in each st across with 2 sc in last st, turn.(6)

Row 18: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Rows 19-24: Repeat rows 17 and 18 alternately. At end of row 24 (12).

Row 25: Ch 1, 2 sc in each st across, turn.(24)

Rows 26-35: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn. At end of last row, fasten off.

Sew ends of rows 1—5 to ends of rows 31-35 for side seams.

For **waist**, working in starting ch and in sts of row 35, join white with sc in any st, sc in

each st and in each ch around, join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

Leg Trim

Rnd 1: Working in ends of rows 6—30, join white with sc in any row, sc in each row around, join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 2: (Ch 2, sl st) in each st around, ch 2, join with sl st in last joining sl st. Fasten off.

BABY'S SHOE (make 2)

Rnd 1: With yellow, ch 6, (beg hdc, 2 hdc) in second ch from hook, sc in each of next 3 chs, 5 hdc in end ch; working on opposite side of starting ch, sc in each of next 3 chs, 2 hdc in same ch as beg hdc, join with sl st in top of beg hdc. (16 sts made)

Rnd 2: (Beg hdc, hdc) in first st, hdc in each of next 2 sts, sc in each of next 3 sts, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next st, 3 hdc in next st, hdc in next st, 2 hdc in next st, sc in each of next 3 sts, hdc in each of last 2 sts, hdc in same st as Beg hdc, join. (22)

Rnd 3: (Beg hdc, hdc) in first st, hdc in next 8 sts, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next st, 3 hdc in next st, hdc in next st, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 8 sts, hdc in same st as beg hdc, join. (28)

Rnd 4: Working in **back lps**, ch 1, sc in each st around, join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, sc in first 10 sts, hdc in next 9 sts, sc in last 9 sts, join.

Rnd 6: Ch 1, sc in first 9 sts, (hdc next 2 sts tog, hdc in next st) 3 times, hdc next 2 sts tog, sc in last 8 sts, join. Fasten off. (24)

Rnd 7: Working in **back lps**, join white with sc in first st, sc in next 7 sts, (dc next 2 sts tog) 2 times, dc in next st, (dc next 2 sts tog) 2 times, sc in last 7 sts, join. (20)

Rnds 8-9: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Rnd 10: Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sts, 2 sc in next st, (sc in each of next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st) around, join. (25)

Rnd 11: Working in **back lps**, ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Rnd 12: Ch 1, **sc fp** (see Stitch Guide) around each st around, join.

Rnd 13: Sl st in each st around, join with sl st in first st. Fasten off.

BABY'S HAT

Row 1: With yellow, ch 38, (beg hdc, ch 1) in second ch from hook, skip next ch, hdc in next ch, (ch 1, skip next ch, hdc in next ch) across, **do not turn**-**Row 2:** Ch 1, 2 sc in side of last st just made, working in starting ch on opposite side of row 1, sc in each ch across, 2 sc in side of first st on row 1, sc in each st and in each ch across on row 1, turn.

Row 3: Working in **back lps**, (beg dc, dc) in first st, 2 dc in each of next 36 sts, sl st in next st, leaving remaining sts unworked, turn,

Row 4: Beg dc in first st, dc in each st across to last st, sl st in last st, turn.

Row 5: Ch 1, sc in each st across to last st, sl st in last st, **do not turn**.

Row 6: Ch 1, **reverse sc** (see Stitch Guide) in each st across to last st, sl st in last st. Fasten off.

Row 7: For **ruffle**, working in **remaining lps** of row 2, join white with sc in first st, shell in next st, (skip next st, dc in next st, skip next st, shell in next st) 3 times, skip next st, dc in next st, shell in next st, skip next st, dc in next st, skip next st, shell in next st, (dc in next st, skip next st, shell in next st, skip next st) 3 times, dc in next st, skip next st, shell in next st, sc in last st, turn.

Row 8: Ch 1, sc in first ch sp, *[ch 3, (sc, picot) in next st, ch 3], sc in each of next 2 ch sps; repeat from * around to last shell; repeat between [], sc in last ch sp, sl st in last st. Fasten off.

BEAR'S DRESS

Row 1: With yellow, ch 21, sc in second ch from hook, 2 sc in next ch, (sc in next ch, 2 sc in next ch) across, turn. (30 sc made)

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 3: Working in **back lps**, ch 1, sc in next 14 sts, 2 sc in each of next 2 sts, sc in next 14 sts, turn. (32)

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in first 5 sts; for **arm-hole**, ch 5, skip next 8 sts; sc in next 6 sts; for **armhole**, ch 5, skip next 8 sts; sc in next 5 sts, turn.

Rnd 5: Working in mds, ch 1, sc in each st and in each ch around, join with sl st in first sc. (26)

Rnd 6: Working in **front lps**, (beg dc, dc) in first st, 2 dc in each st around, join with sl st in top of beg dc.

Rnd 7: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join.

Rnd 8: Working in **back lps**, beg dc in first st, dc in each st around, join.

Rnd 9: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join. Fasten off.

Rnd 10: Working in **back lps**, join white with sl st in first st, sl st in each st around, join with sl st in first sl st. Fasten off.

Rnd 11: For **bottom ruffle**, working in **remaining lps** on rnd 7, skip first st, join white with sl st in next st, (ch 5, dc, ch 2, dc) in same st as sl st, skip next 2 sts, (shell in next st, skip next 2 sts) around, join with sl st in third ch of ch-5.

Rnd 12: Ch 1, sc in first ch sp, * [ch 3, (sc, picot) in next st, ch 3], sc in each of next 2 ch sps; repeat from * around to last shell; repeat between [], sc in last ch sp, join. Fasten off.

Rnd 13: For **top ruffle**, working in **remaining lps** of rnd 5; repeat rnd 11.

Rnd 14: Repeat rnd 12.

Row 15: For **bodice ruffle**, working in **remaining lps** on row 2, join white with sc in first st, (ch 1, sc) in each st across. Fasten off.

Row 16: For **back placket**, working in ends of rows across back opening, join yellow with sc in first row, sc in each row across, sl st in joining sl st, sc in each row across, sl st in starting ch. Fasten off.

Row 17: For **ties**, with white, ch 25; working in starting ch on opposite side of row 1, sc in each ch across, ch 25. Fasten off.

Tie 6" piece of 1/8" ribbon in bow around center st at front.
