DOLL'S OUTFIT

MATERIALS: You will need 2 balls Beehive Astra (50 g). One 3.50 mm (U.S. E or 4) crochet hook or whichever hook you require to produce the tension given below. **Dress:** Length of ribbon. 3 small buttons. **Panties:** 12 inch (31 cm) length of elastic.

MEASUREMENTS: To fit doll with 13 inch (33 cm) chest measurement. Height approx 16 ins (41 cm).

TENSION: 4½ shells = 4 ins (10 cm) over bodice pattern.

COMPLETE SATISFACTION IS ONLY GUARANTEED WHEN YOU WORK TO EXACT TENSION WITH THE SPECIFIED YARN.

DRESS

BODICE: Beginning at waist ch 62 sts.

****Foundation row:** (Right side). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of ch. Ch 3. Turn. (61 sts in row).

2nd row: Miss 1st st. 1 dc in next st. *Ch 1. Miss 1 st. 1 dc in each of next 2 sts. Repeat from * to last 2 sts. Ch 1. Miss 1 st. 1 dc in last st. Ch 1. Turn.

3rd row: Miss 1st st. *1 sc in next ch space. 1 sc in each of next 2 sts. Repeat from * to end of row. Ch 3. Turn. (Eyelet row completed).

Next row: 2 dc in 1st st. *Miss 3 sts. (2 dc. Ch 1. 2 dc) for shell in next st. Repeat from * to last 4 sts. Miss 3 sts. 3 dc in last st. Turn.

Next row: Ch 3. 2 dc in 1st st. *Shell in centre of next shell. Repeat from * ending with 3 dc in top of ch 3. Turn.** Last row forms bodice pattern.

To make right back: **Next row:** Ch 3. 2 dc in 1st st. (Shell in centre of next shell)twice. 3 dc in centre of next shell. Turn.

Next row: Ch 3. 2 dc in 1st st. (Shell in centre of next shell)twice. 3 dc in top of ch 3. Turn. Repeat last row twice. Fasten off.

To make front: **Next row:** With wrong side of work facing and leaving 1 shell for underarm, join yarn in centre of next shell. Ch 3. 2 dc in same space. (Shell in centre of next shell)4 times. 3 dc in centre of next shell. Turn.

Next row: Ch 3. 2 dc in 1st st. (Shell in centre of next shell)4 times. 3 dc in top of ch 3. Turn. Repeat last row twice.

To shape neck: **Next row:** Ch 3. 2 dc in 1st st. 3 dc in centre of next shell. Turn. **Next row:** Ch 3. 2 dc in 1st st. 3 dc in top of ch 3. Turn. Repeat last row once. Fasten off.

With wrong side of work facing and leaving 2 shells for front of neck, join yarn in centre of next shell and work to correspond to other side.

To make left back: With wrong side of work facing and leaving 1 shell for underarm, join yarn in centre of next shell. Work to correspond to right back.

SKIRT: With right side of work facing, join yarn to foundation ch of bodice and proceed as follows:-

1st row: Ch 3. 2 dc in 1st ch. *Ch 3. Miss 1 ch. 1 sc in next ch. Ch 3. Miss 1 ch. Shell in next ch. Repeat from * to last 4 ch. Ch 3. Miss 1 ch. 1 sc in next ch. Ch 3. Miss 1 ch. 3 dc in last ch. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 3. 2 dc in 1st st. *Ch 2. 1 sc in next ch space. Ch 4. 1 sc in next ch space. Ch 2. Shell in centre of next shell. Repeat from * ending last repeat with 3 dc in top of ch 3. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 3. 2 dc in 1st st. *Ch 3. Miss next ch space. 1 sc in next ch 4 space. Ch 3. Miss next ch space. Shell in centre of next shell. Repeat from * ending last repeat with 3 dc in top of ch 3. Turn. Repeat last 2 rows for pattern 4 times. Fasten off.

SLEEVES: Ch 36 sts.

Foundation row: 2 dc in 4th ch from hook. *Miss 3 ch. Shell in next ch. Repeat from * to last 4 ch. Miss 3 ch. 3 dc in last ch. Turn.

Work 3 rows in bodice pattern. Fasten off.

TO MAKE UP: Sew shoulder and sleeve seams. Sew in sleeves. Sew back seam for 2½ ins (6 cm) from lower edge. With right side of work facing, work 1 row sc along left side of back opening. Fasten off.

With wrong side of work facing, work 2 rows sc along right side of back opening working 3 buttonholes evenly spaced as follows:- Ch 2. Miss 1 st.

Sew buttons to correspond to buttonholes. Do not press. Pin to measurements and cover with a damp cloth, leaving to dry on garment. Thread ribbon through eyelets at waist.

PANTIES

Beginning at waist, ch 74 sts and work from ** to ** as given for dress. Repeat last row 5 times. Fasten off.

To shape crotch: With right side of work facing, join yarn in 8th ch space. Ch 3. 2 dc in same space. Shell in centre of next shell. 3 dc in centre of next shell. Turn.

Next row: Ch 3. 2 dc in 1st st. Shell in centre of next shell. 3 dc in top of ch 3. Turn. Repeat last row 4 times. Fasten off.

TO MAKE UP: Sew back seam. Sew crotch in position at centre back. Work 7 shells evenly spaced around each leg opening. Thread elastic through eyelets at waist.

PREEMIE DOLL'S CHRISTENING ROBE, PANTIES, BOOTEES AND BONNET.

MATERIALS: 3 balls Beehive Astra (50 g). One 3.50 mm (U.S. E or 4) crochet hook or whichever hook you require to produce the tension given below. **Robe:** Length of ribbon. 3 small buttons. **Panties:** 11 inch (28 cm) length of elastic. **Bonnet:** Length of ribbon.

MEASUREMENTS: To fit doll with approx 12½ inch (32 cm) chest measurement. Height approx 14 ins (36 cm).

TENSION: 4½ shells = 4 ins (10 cm) over bodice pattern.

CHRISTENING ROBE

BODICE: Beginning at waist ch 54 sts.

****Foundation row:** (Right side). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of ch. Ch 3. Turn. (53 sts in row).

2nd row: Miss 1st st. 1 dc in next st. *Ch 1. Miss 1 st. 1 dc in each of next 2 sts. Repeat from * to end of row. Ch 1. Turn.

3rd row: Miss 1st st. 1 sc in next st. *1 sc in next ch space. 1 sc in each of next 2 sts. Repeat from * to end of row. Turn.** (Eyelet row completed).

To make right back: **Next row:** Ch 3. 2 dc in 1st st. Miss 3 sts. (2 dc. Ch 1. 2 dc) for shell in next st. Miss 3 sts. 3 dc in next st. Turn.

Next row: Ch 3. 2 dc in 1st st. Shell in centre of next shell. 3 dc in top of ch 3. Turn. Repeat last row twice. Fasten off.

To make front: **Next row:** With wrong side of work facing and leaving next 7 sts for underarm, join yarn in next st. Ch 3. 2 dc in same st. (Miss 3 sts. Shell in next st)4 times. Miss 3 sts. 3 dc in next st. Turn.

Next row: Ch 3. 2 dc in 1st st. (Shell in centre of next shell)4 times. 3 dc in top of ch 3. Turn. Repeat last row twice.

To shape neck: **Next row:** Ch 3. 2 dc in 1st st. 3 dc in centre of next shell. Turn. **Next row:** Ch 3. 2 dc in 1st st. 3 dc in top of ch 3. Turn. Repeat last row once. Fasten off.

With wrong side of work facing and leaving 2 shells for front of neck, join yarn in centre of next shell and work to correspond to other side.

To make left back: With wrong side of work facing and leaving 7 sts for underarm, join yarn in next st. Work to correspond to right back.

SKIRT: With right side of work facing, join yarn to foundation ch of bodice and proceed as follows:-

1st row: Ch 3. 2 dc in 1st ch. *Ch 3. Miss 1 ch. 1 sc in next ch. Ch 3. Miss 1 ch. Shell in next ch. Repeat from * to last 4 ch. Ch 3. Miss 1 ch. 1 sc in next ch. Ch 3. Miss 1 ch. 3 dc in last ch. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 3. 2 dc in 1st st. *Ch 2. 1 sc in next ch space. Ch 4. 1 sc in next ch space. Ch 2. Shell in centre of next shell. Repeat from * ending last repeat with 3 dc in top of ch 3. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 3. 2 dc in 1st st. *Ch 3. Miss next ch space. 1 sc in next ch 4 space. Ch 3. Miss next ch space. Shell in centre of next shell. Repeat from * ending last repeat with 3 dc in top of ch 3. Turn. Repeat last 2 rows for pattern 12 times. Fasten off.

SLEEVES: Ch 32 sts.

Foundation row: 2 dc in 4th ch from hook. *Miss 3 ch. Shell in next ch. Repeat from * to last 4 ch. Miss 3 ch. 3 dc in last ch. Turn.

Next row: Ch 3. 2 dc in 1st st. *Shell in centre of next shell. Repeat from * ending with 3 dc in top of ch 3. Turn. Repeat last row twice.

Next row: Ch 1. Miss 1st st. 1 sc in next st. *Miss next st. 1 sc in space between shells. Miss next st. 1 sc in next st. 1 sc in ch 1 space of shell. 1 sc in next st. Repeat from * 3 times. Miss next st. 1 sc in space between shells. Miss next st. 1 sc in next st. 1 sc in top of ch 3. Turn.

Next row: Ch 3. Miss 1st st. 1 dc in next st. *Ch 1. Miss 1 st. 1 dc in each of next 2 sts. Repeat from * to end of row. Turn.

Next row: Ch 1. Miss 1st st. 1 sc in next st. *1 sc in next ch space. 1 sc in each of next 2 sts. Repeat from * to end of row. Fasten off.

TO MAKE UP: Sew shoulder and sleeve seams. Sew in sleeves. Sew back seam for 9 ins (23 cm) from lower edge. With right side of work facing, work 1 row sc along left side of back opening. Fasten off.

With wrong side of work facing, work 2 rows sc along right side of back opening working 3 buttonholes evenly spaced as follows:- Ch 2. Miss 1 st.

Sew buttons to correspond to buttonholes. Do not press. Pin to measurements and cover with a damp cloth, leaving to dry on garment. Thread ribbon through eyelets at waist and wrists.

PANTIES: Beginning at waist, ch 66 sts and work from ** to ** as given for robe.

Next row: Ch 3. 2 dc in 1st st. *Miss 3 sts. Shell in next st. Repeat from * to last 4 sts. Miss 3 sts. 3 dc in last st. Turn.

Next row: Ch 3. 2 dc in 1st st. *Shell in centre of next shell. Repeat from * ending with 3 dc in top of ch 3. Turn. Repeat last row 4 times. Fasten off.

To shape crotch: Next row: With wrong side of work facing, join yarn in 8th ch space. Ch 3. 2 dc in same space. 3 dc in centre of next shell. Turn.

Next row: Ch 3. 2 dc in 1st st. 3 dc in top of ch 3. Turn. Repeat last row 5 times. Fasten off.

TO MAKE UP: Sew back seam. Sew crotch in position at centre back. Work 7 shells evenly spaced around each leg opening. Thread elastic through eyelets at waist.

BOOTEES: Ch 32 sts.

Foundation row: 2 dc in 4th ch from hook. *Miss 3 ch. Shell in next ch. Repeat from * to last 4 ch. Miss 3 ch. 3 dc in last ch. Turn.

Next row: Ch 3. 2 dc in 1st st. *Shell in centre of next shell. Repeat from * ending with 3 dc in top of ch 3. Turn. Repeat last row 6 times. Fasten off.

Fold in half, side edge to side edge. Sew bottom and side edges. With double strand of yarn, make a chain 16 ins (41 cm) long for lace. Thread between shells at ankles.

BONNET: Beginning at crown, ch 11 sts. **1st row:** 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each of next 7 ch. 2 sc in next ch. 3 sc in last ch. Working back along opposite side of starting ch, work 2 sc in next ch. 1 sc in each ch to end of ch. Turn. (23 sts in row).

2nd row: Ch 1. Miss 1st st. 1 sc in each of next 8 sts. 2 sc in next st. 1 sc in next st. 3 sc in next st. 1 sc in next st. 2 sc in next st. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn. (27 sts in row).

3rd row: Ch 1. Miss 1st st. 1 sc in each of next 9 sts. (2 sc in next st. 1 sc in next st) 3 times. 2 sc in next st. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn. (31 sts in row).

4th row: Ch 1. Miss 1st st. Ss in each of next 2 sts. 1 sc in each of next 6 sts. *2 sc in next st. 1 sc in each of next 2 sts. 2 sc in next st.* 1 sc in each of next 3 sts. Repeat from * to * once. 1 sc in each of next 6 sts. Ss in each st to end of row. Turn. (36 sts in row).

5th row: Ch 1. Miss 1st st. 1 sc in each st to end of row, increasing 1 st at top of curve. Turn. (37 sts in row).

Next row: Ch 3. 2 dc in 1st st. *Miss 3 sts. Shell in next st. Repeat from * to last 4 sts. Miss 3 sts. 3 dc in last st. Turn.

Next row: Ch 3. 2 dc in 1st st. *Shell in centre of next shell. Repeat from * ending with 3 dc in top of ch 3. Turn. Repeat last row 3 times.

Next row: Ch 1. 1 sc in 1st st. 1 sc in next st. *Miss next st. 1 sc in space

between shells. Miss next st. 1 sc in next st. 1 sc in ch 1 space of shell. 1 sc in next st. Repeat from * 7 times. Miss next st. 1 sc in space between shells. Miss next st. 1 sc in next st. 1 sc in top of ch 3. Turn.

Next row: Ch 3. Miss 1st st. 1 dc in next st. *Ch 1. Miss 1 st. 1 dc in each of next 2 sts. Repeat from * to last 3 sts. Ch 1. Miss 1 st. 1 dc in next st. 1 dc in top of turning ch. Turn.

Next row: Ch 1. Miss 1st st. 1 sc in next st. *1 sc in next ch space, 1 sc in each of next 2 sts. Repeat from * to end of row. Turn.

Next row: Ch 1. Miss 1st st. 1 sc in next st. *(1 dc. Ch 3. Ss in 3rd ch from hook for picot) 3 times 1 dc all in next st. 1 sc in next st. Repeat from * ending last repeat with 1 sc in turning ch. Fasten off. Thread ribbon through eyelets around face edge.
